 - e) Gary Mole's percentage ownership in Franklin.
- 1.6 Provide a description of Gary Mole's current ownership interest in Glacial Energy of Texas, Inc. Also, include details regarding his ownership history and current ownership interest, including ownership percentage as well as any and all direct or indirect ownership interest Mr. Mole currently holds or has previously held in Glacial and its affiliates.
- 1.7 Provide a comprehensive list of all Glacial's and its parent company's Boards of Directors, including names, addresses, and telephone numbers and dates of service, from the date of inception to the present.
- 1.8 Provide a comprehensive list of Glacial's officers and employees, including names, titles, addresses, telephone numbers and dates of service, from the date of inception to the present.
- 1.9 What are the name(s), title(s) and addresses of all persons that currently have, or have ever had, control over Glacial, either directly or indirectly, and/or own or have owned at any time more than 10% of Glacial?

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- 1.10 Is there any person(s) named in the responses to the preceding requests for information that was a principal of a REP or employed by a REP that experienced a mass transition of the REP's customers to POLR? If so, what are their name(s), title(s) and addresses?
- 1.11 Describe in detail any and all efforts made to secure additional financing for Franklin to avert a mass transition of its customers to the provider of last resort (POLR) in 2005.
 Explain all particulars of such efforts, including an explanation of why such efforts failed. Also, provide all relevant documents, including e-mails, associated with Franklin's efforts to secure such additional financing.
- 1.12 Describe, in detail, the services that Gary Mole provided, through Essential Utilities Corporation, to Franklin, along with the compensation related to such services. Also provide a copy of the contract and any related documents for such services.
- 1.13 Following the mass transition of its customers to the POLR in 2005, did Franklin:
 - a) Process the final meter reads for customer;
 - b) Settle (i.e., pay) financial obligations to customers;
 - c) File with the Commission a sworn affidavit demonstrating compliance with Commission rules regarding financial obligations to refund customers following the transition to POLR? If so, provide documentation in support thereof; and if not, explain why; and,
 - d) Comply with the Commission rules §§ 25.107(f)(2), 25.107(i)(8), 25.478(j)(2) and 25.43(n)(7) as they existed at that time? If so, provide documentation in support thereof, and if not, explain why.
- 1.14 Provide a copy of Franklin's Electricity Facts Label (EFL) and Terms of Service (TOS) documents that were in effect as of May 12, 2011.
- 1.15 Provide a current list of Glacial's creditors, including the amount of indebtedness for each creditor. Also, provide a copy of all indentures, notes, bonds, mortgages and any other documents relating to Glacial's credit and/or loan obligations.

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- 1.16 Has Glacial ever issued credits/refunds to its customers in response to complaints about the actual kWh rate(s) billed to its customers and/or complaints regarding overbilling? If so, provide a detailed description of the justification, number and frequency of issuing such credits/refunds. Also provide the original bill, revised bill and underlying work papers and all supporting documentation for the five largest credits/refunds ever issued to five different Glacial customers.
- 1.17 If the kWh rate was recalculated for any customer, did Glacial recalculate the bills and issue credits/refunds for those customers who were billed the same rate but who did not complain about the kWh rate? Explain your answer.
- 1.18 Provide a copy of the bills for a customer with a "variable rate" product that also received a credit/refund in response to a complaint about the actual, billed kWh rate for each month between May 2010 and May of 2011. Also provide a copy of all work papers and all supporting documentation underlying the calculation of each of the kilowatt hour (kWh) rates that was applied to kWh consumption on each these bills.
- 1.19 Provide a copy of all work papers and all supporting documentation underlying the calculation of the Kilowatt Hour (kWh) rate that was applied to kWh consumption on variable-rate customer bills in June 2012.
- 1.20 For each of the product types provided by Glacial, provide a detailed explanation of the application of the "retail adder" including the value of the adder, by month that was used to determine the actual price/rate per kWh that appeared on customer bills.
- 1.21 For Glacial's "variable rate" products, provide the kWh rate, by month, and by product that appeared on customer bills.
- 1.22 Provide a copy of all price-related change notices provided to customers pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.475(d)(2) in calendar years 2010, 2011 and 2012.
- 1.23 Provide the following information for Glacial and its affiliates: complaint history, disciplinary record, and compliance record from any federal agency including the U.S.

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Securities and Exchange Commission, any self-regulatory organization relating to the sales of securities, financial instruments, or other financial transactions; state public utility commissions, state attorney general offices, or other regulatory agencies in states where the applicant is doing business or has conducted business in the past including state securities boards or commissions, the Texas Secretary of State, Texas Comptroller's Office, and Office of the Texas Attorney General. Include the type of complaint, status of complaint, resolution of complaint, and the number of customers in each state where complaints occurred.

- 1.24 Provide information regarding the status of Glacial and all affiliates' authorizations to provide gas and/or electric service in states other than Texas. Include the date of the initial application for certification; docket number, date of approval or rejection, date of suspension or revocation and the current status of all previously filed applications.
- 1.25 Provide a description of all entities affiliated with Energy West Resources, Ltd. d/b/a
