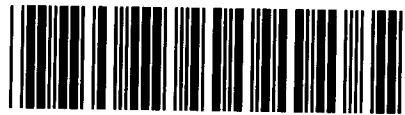


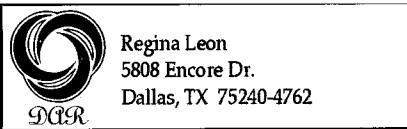

Dear PUC Commissioners, and Chairman Nelson;

I am very concerned about further installations of the Smart Meters as outlined in the Petition submitted by Devvy Kidd and John Kidd. I agree with the termination of future installations until the health & safety concerns are resolved with regard to the radiation of radio frequency and electromagnetic field energy to transmit data from the Smart Meters on a nearly continuous basis that may affect biological health of persons and animals in close proximity to the meters.

The PUC is charged with Consumer Protection, and this is an issue of extreme importance regarding the protection of the health and well being of Texans.

Additionally, I object to the meters as they are a violation to my 4th Amendment Right to Privacy, since the meters collect data that is specific as to detail my usage of electricity approximately down to the minute, and can bear the load signatures of the devices and equipment used within my home. I do not recall giving the TDU or Electricity Provider any permission to collect such personal data, nor should any implied consent be acceptable in regards to such detailed personal information.

I DO NOT want to have a Smart Meter installed at my residence, or on any other homes near mine. If one has already been installed at my residence, I want it removed and replaced with my previous style meter. I revoke any previous "implied consent" considered by the Utilities to have authorized the installation of any so-called 'smart meter'. My total electricity for a given month is all you need for billing purposes, as for my personal usage details, that is my business alone.

Please grant a public hearing immediately, to allow the petitioners and other concerned citizens to present evidence and testimony. Please, also declare a moratorium until such information from the hearing can be assimilated, and studied so as to come to an informed decision on the future of the 'Smart Meters' in Texas.
