SOAH ORDER NO. 5
ADMISSION OF DOCUMENTS; REMANDING CASE TO COMMISSION;
AND DISMISSAL OF SOAH DOCKET

On December 10, 2012, Wind Energy Transmission Texas, LLC (WETT); Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission); the Office of Public Utility Counsel (OPC); Texas Industrial Energy Consumers (TIEC); and the Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor (Cities) filed a Joint Motion for Remand for Review and Approval of Stipulation. Oncor Electric Delivery Company (Oncor) authorized the parties to represent that it does not oppose the stipulation. The motion stated that the parties in this case have fully settled all contested issues, and request the admission of evidence to support the settlement.


