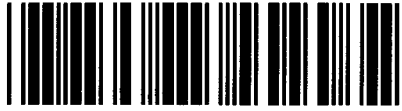

### **NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF WITHDRAWAL**

On September 21, 2012, MRDB Holding, LP d/b/a LPB Energy Consulting (LPB Energy) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to withdraw its registration as an Aggregator pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.111.

On September 25, 2012, Commission Staff recommended that LPB Energy be permitted to withdraw its registration, based upon its voluntary request to withdraw, and because LPB Energy stated that it has not collected any advance payments from aggregation customers. Additionally, LPB Energy merged with Bridge Acquisition Corp, Inc. (Bridge). Bridge merged into Ecova, a registered aggregator. Ecova is the sole surviving entity, effective February 3, 2012.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, LPB Energy's application to withdraw its registration as an Aggregator is approved.<sup>1</sup> LPB Energy's registration No. 80037 is withdrawn.
