Re: SOAH Docket No. 473-13-0821, PUC Docket No. 40684; Application of LCRA Transmission Services Corporation to Amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for the Proposed EC Mornhinweg to Parkway 138-kV Transmission Line in Comal and Guadalupe Counties

## Dear Judges Summerhays and Bierman:

At the prehearing last week I committed to you and the parties that LCRA TSC would soon have available for review on its website the entire CCN filing in this docket. That project has now been completed. While the parties are encouraged to refer to the PUC's Interchange for filings, orders, and pleadings they may also refer to LCRA TSC's website for a complete electronic copy of LCRA TSC's CCN filing in this case, including access to all maps contained in the filing. You might recall that in our discussion at the prehearing we noted that the PUC will not upload to the Interchange the maps contained in the filing due to space limitations. Now you, Staff, and the parties can access the entire CCN filing from our website and can print off copies of any files of interest, including the maps. Also, this day LCRA TSC filed its Supplemental Mailer's Affidavit. Mr. Powell's affidavit includes an exhibit listing all the persons whose notice packets were returned, the action taken to resend those packets to the named individuals, and the resulting cases in which despite LCRA TSC's best efforts, certain addressees could not be located. LCRA TSC believes it has now complied with all notice requirements. At the prehearing last week I noted that Order No. 5 approved the text of LCRA TSC's notice as well as LCRA TSC's provision of notice. If any further approval of notice is necessary LCRA TSC would respectfully request that the ALJs issue an order expressly approving LCRA TSC's notice in this case.

During the prehearing I mentioned to the parties that LCRA TSC's "Intervenor Map" was not yet complete. The copy shown and discussed at the prehearing is currently a work-in-progress and will remain so until such time as all intervenors have been admitted and all intervenors clarify which parcels of land they actually own. Nonetheless, I anticipate that immediately after the Thanksgiving holiday we will post the intervenor map on our website – again with the caveat

that it is a continuing work-in-progress – for the intervenors' use and reference. LCRA TSC will let you and the parties know exactly when the intervenor map is posted.

Finally, immediately after the prehearing we discovered on one of the counsel tables a notebook marked "confidential." We left the notebook with the SOAH docketing clerks and asked that they deliver the notebook to you. Any attorney who is missing a notebook is encouraged to contact you to retrieve his or her belongings.
