## **AMMENDED SOAH ORDER NO. 2** MEMORIALIZING DECISIONS MADE AT **JULY 22, 2013 PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On July 22, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., the administrative law judge (ALJ) convened a prehearing conference following notice. In attendance were:

On July 19, 2013, ETT and Sharyland, Applicants, filed a proposed schedule, including a proposed four-day hearing on the merits for October 8 through 11, 2013. No objections to the proposed schedule were filed. The ALJ adopts the proposed prehearing schedule and hearing dates. Ms. McPhee noted that some of the deadlines are very close to the events following them. In response, the Applicants agreed that if a party has a concern about a particular deadline as it arises, then the party may contact the affected parties, seek an agreement to an extension, or, failing to obtain an agreement, file a written motion or request with the ALJ.

Other than the motion to intervene filed by James McAllen, Applicants had no objection to the admission of the rest of the requests for intervention. Applicant asked for additional time in which to determine whether Mr. McAllen's request satisfies the Commission's intervention requirements. Other than Mr. McAllen's request, the ALJ grants the filed requests to intervene through Document 68 on the Commission's Interchange.

Applicants requested that the deadline for filing an objection to Mr. McAllen's intervention be extended to 5:00 p.m., Friday, July 26, 2013. The balance of the requests for intervention will be addressed at the second prehearing conference to be held at 10:00 a.m., August 30, 2013.

The ALJ ruled that service by email will be permitted with any party who submits an email address.

Applicants announced that they intended to file proof of notice later in the week.

Any issues not addressed in this hearing may be addressed in the second prehearing conference, set for August 30, 2013.
