2	Q.	Please state your name, title and address.		
3	A.	My name is Leonel Galaviz. I am the Superintendent of Schools for the Valley View		
4	Independent	School District in the Hidalgo/Pharr, Texas area in Hidalgo County, Texas ("District").		
5	5 My business address is 9701 S. Jackson Rd., Pharr, TX 78577.			
6	Q.	Have you ever participated or testified in another proceeding before the Public		
7 Utility Commission of Texas ("PUC")?

10	А.	I am testifying on behalf of District and on behalf of the students who attend schools		
11	11 located on property owned by the District.			
12	Q.	Please describe the District's interest in SOAH Docket No. 41606		
13	А.	The District is an intervener in this proceeding. The District owns property in		
14	14 Hidalgo County, Texas, most of which (the "Affected Property") might be impacted by the			
15	transmission	line that Electric Transmission Texas ("ETT") and Sharyland Utilities propose to build.

20	Q.	What is the purpose of your testimony?		
21	А.	The purpose of my testimony is to: (i) describe the Affected Property; (ii) describe		
22	the expected impact of the proposed transmission line; (iii) and voice the District's opposition against			
23	23 certain links and routes.			
24	Q.	Is the information contained in your testimony true and correct to the best of		
25	your knowle	edge and belief?

28		III. DESCRIPTION OF THE AFFECTED PROPERTY AND IMPACT OF THE		
29		TRANSMISSION LINE ON THE AFFECTED PROPERTY		
30	Q.	Please describe the District and its purpose.

A. The District is a Division 4A school located in Hidalgo/Pharr Texas area and is dedicated to the education and well being of its students. A growing community of approximately ten square miles support the District by actively participating in the education of the students. The District includes four elementary schools, one fifth grade campus, one early college school, one junior high, and one high school. The District is committed to the education of the students and offers advance placement programs, counseling for higher education, after school activities, and other school related programs.

#### Please describe the Affected Property.

A. Most of the District's campuses are affected by links proposed by ETT and Sharyland
Utilities, specifically the following campuses that are located on the Affected Property: Wilbur E.
Lucas Elementary School, located at 1300 S. McColl Rd, Hidalgo, Texas 78557; Valley View
Elementary School, located at 3408 E. Olmos St., Hidalgo, Texas 78577; Valley View North
Elementary School, located at 1000 W. Anaya Road, Pharr, Texas 78577; Valley View High School,
located at 600 N. Jackson Rd., Pharr, Texas 78557; and Valley View Junior High School and Fifth
Grade Campus, located at 9601 and 9701 S. Jackson Rd., Pharr, Texas 78557.

#### Q. What link or links would affect the District's property?

A. The Affected Property will be impacted by the transmission line ETT and Sharyland
Utilities propose to build if any route is approved by the PUC that contains Links 115, 120, 121
and/or 122.

## Q. Do Links 115, 120, 121 and/or 122 cross the District's property?

A. Yes. Link 115 crosses an approximately 20-acre tract owned by the District just north of Lucas Elementary School that is being held by the District for future development. Link 122 crosses District property that is located just to west of Jackson Road that the District intends to use for future development, including construction of new central administration offices.

In addition, Link 115 appears to run within 1000 feet of Wilbur E. Lucas Elementary School and Valley View Elementary School, and Link 122 appears to run within 1000 feet of multiple campuses, including Valley View Elementary School, Valley View High School, and Valley View Junior High School and Fifth Grade Campus. Link 121 appears to run within 1000 feet of Valley View North Elementary School and the District's Central Kitchen, Maintenance Complex and Transportation Complex.

Q. Please describe the Property's current and planned uses and operations and how those uses and operations would be affected by the construction of a transmission line.

3 Α. As stated above, the District operates multiple primary and secondary school campuses on the Affected Property. Link 115 passes within 1000 feet of Wilbur E. Lucas 4 5 Elementary School and Valley View Elementary School, which presently have a combined 6 enrollment of 1,050 students. Links 120 and 122 also appear to be within 1000 feet of Valley View 7 Elementary School, which has an enrollment of 550 students. Link 122 appears to be within 1000 8 feet of three primary schools (Valley View Elementary School, Valley View Fifth Grade Campus 9 and Valley View Junior High School) and Valley View High School. The combined enrollment of 10 these primary school campuses is 1,650 students, and Valley View High School, 1,200 students. 11 Link 121 appears to run within 1000 feet of Valley View North Elementary, which has an enrollment of 500 students. Also, near Valley View North Elementary, and within 1000 feet of Link 121, the 12 13 District operates its Central Kitchen, where meals are prepared for the District's various campuses, 14 and the District's Maintenance and Transportation Complexes.

In addition, the District owns an approximately 20-acre tract just north of Wilbur E. Lucas Elementary School that District intends to use for future development, including future schools or facilities. If approved, any route containing Link 115, which crosses through this tract, will adversely impact the District's ability to utilize this tract for such purposes. In addition, Link 122 crosses existing undeveloped District property to the west of S. Jackson Road that the District intends to use for future central administration offices. If any route containing Link 122 is approved, the District's ability to use this property for its intended purposes will be adversely affected.

22 Q. Approximately how many students attend schools located on the Affected 23 Property?

A. Approximately a total of 3,850 students attend campuses located on the AffectedProperty.

26 Q. Please describe any habitable structures and other improvements on the 27 Affected Property and how they would be affected by the construction of a transmission line.

A. Each of the campuses operated by the District on the Affected Property comprise
school buildings used as classrooms, gymnasiums, and auditoriums. In addition, each campus has
outdoors a baseball field and physical education areas. In addition to these, the Valley View High

School has two football practice fields. Near Valley View North Elementary School, the District maintains its Central Kitchen, Maintenance Complex and Transportation Complex. The District is deeply concerned that transmission lines built using Links 115, 120, 121 or 122 will be "attractive nuisances" that will be prove to be inviting to District students, who are naturally curious and may try to get near or climb on transmission towers. Given the extreme voltages that are proposed to be run through these lines, the consequences of such action by students could lead to extreme bodily harm or death.

# 8 Q. Do any existing transmission or distribution lines encumber the Affected 9 Property?

A. Yes, the Affected Property is already encumbered by one set of transmission lines
that cross District property comprising the Valley View High School. There are also electric
distribution lines that provide electricity to the buildings on the Property.

13Q.How would the Affected Property's current and planned uses and operations be14affected by the construction of a transmission line using Links 115, 120, 121 and/or 122?

15 A. As stated above, the District is concerned that such a transmission line, so close to multiple primary and secondary school campuses, will adversely affect the health and safety of its 16 students who attend those campuses and the staff who work there. Additionally, the lines will impact 17 the District's intended future and current use of the Affected Property, including the District's ability 18 19 to utilize the approximately 20-acre tract just north of Wilbur E. Lucas Elementary School, where Link 115 runs, for future development, including future schools or facilities; and the District's ability 20 to use existing undeveloped District property to the west of S. Jackson Road use for future central 21 22 administration offices.

# Q. What other concerns does the District have concerning the construction of a transmission line?

A. In addition to its concern for its students, teachers and other staff who attend school and work on campuses and facilities located on the Affected Property, the District is concerned for the safety and welfare of residents of communities that the District serves. Many of these residents live near District campuses and thus also will be affected by Links 115, 120, 121 and 122. The District also questions why it would ever be necessary to route the proposed transmission lines through Links 115, 120, 121 and 122 given the clear, unpopulated access afforded by the levees to

the north of the District. To the District, it makes no sense to locate any of the proposed transmission 1 2 line route south of those levees.

### **IV. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

Please summarize your position in this proceeding regarding ETT's and 4 **Q**. Sharyland Utilities' proposed alternative routes for the North Edinburg to Loma Alta 5 **Transmission Line Project.** 6

7 A. The District is very strongly opposed to Links 115, 120, 121 and 122 and the alternative routes that utilize such links, including Routes 2 (Link 121), 4 (Links 115, 122), 6 (Links 8 120, 122), 7 (Link 121), 9 (Link 121), 10 (Link 121), 12 (Link 121), 13 (Links 115, 120), 14 (Links 9 120, 122), 23 (Links 115, 122), 24 (Links 115, 122), 26 (Links 115, 122), and 30 (Links 115, 122). 10 The District is opposed to Links 115, 120, 121 and 122 as they pose a potential health and safety 11 12 concern for hundreds of the District's students and staff and would interfere with the District's future use and development of its property, thereby unduly interfering with the District's mission to produce 13 responsible and productive citizens from the surrounding communities. 14
