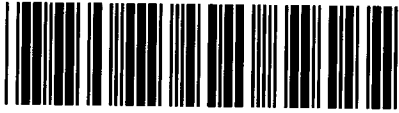




Re: Cross Valley Project

To whom it may concern:


We wish to intervene in the proposed N/S line in Link 142 that in effect separates a 30 acre tract (Lots 20, 21 and 22, Caledonian Estates) owned partly by Dorothy Baetz Jackson Living Trust (Tract 129386 and 629409) and partly by her four children and three of their spouses, with my son, Kenneth E. Jackson, Jr. having power of attorney regarding Tract 692039 and partly by the Dorothy Jackson Living Trust Tracts 129386 and 629409. None of these seven owners were notified about the Cross Valley Project. This separation will have an adverse effect on their property.

At present, it is being successfully leased, farmed, and irrigated as one thirty-acre tract but is intended as future prime residential property in keeping with the surrounding land that has already been developed.
