I do not approve or consent to the construction or installation of any type of electrical power transmission lines or easements for the following reasons:

- Loss of property value at an average rate of 12.8 % to 30.7% as determined in the study "Valuation Guidelines for Properties with Electric Transmission Lines" by Kurt C. Kielisch.
- California Department of Health concluded that Electromagnetic Fields (EMFs) were responsible for an increase in childhood leukemia, adult brain cancer, Lou Gehrig's disease, miscarriages, and specifically linked high voltage lines with birth defects and lymphoma.
