The placement of Segment 266 on our property would severely restrict the area used for the Lessor's business and would probably result in the loss of the rental revenue. The transmission line would be a detriment to the future sale or development of our property. Since the ultimate end-point of the proposed line is to the south and east of San Benito it would make more sense for one of the more southern routes to be utilized.
