



RAY AUDAS' RESPONSE TO ENTERGY TEXAS, INC.'S MOTION FOR AN ORDER REQUIRING PARTIES TO DESIGNATE WITNESSES FOR CROSS-EXAMINATION

On May 5, 2014, Entergy Texas, Inc. (ETI) filed a motion requesting that the administrative law judge (ALJ) issue an order requiring parties to designate the witnesses they intend to cross-examine at the hearing scheduled for May 28-30, 2014.
