#### (STAFF DRAFT RECOMMENDATION) PROPOSAL FOR PUBLICATION OF AMENDMENT TO §25.304 FOR CONSIDERATION AT THE SEPTEMBER 12, 2013 OPEN MEETING

The Public Utility Commission of Texas (commission) proposes an amendment to §25.304, relating to Nuclear Decommissioning Funding and Requirements for Power Generation Companies, to implement House Bill 994 of the 83<sup>rd</sup> Legislature, Regular Session in 2013 (HB 994). The proposed amendment would extend from January 15, 2015 to January 1, 2033 the date by which construction of a qualifying nuclear generating unit shall start in order for the terms that are established in the rule to apply to its decommissioning trust. Project Number 41747 is assigned to this proceeding.

8 Slade Cutter, Senior Financial Analyst, Rate Regulation Division, has determined that for each
9 year of the first five-year period the section is in effect there will be no fiscal implications for
10 state or local government as a result of enforcing or administering the section.

Mr. Cutter has determined that for each year of the first five years the proposed section is in effect the public benefit anticipated as a result of enforcing the section will be compliance with HB 994 and PURA §39.206. There will be no adverse economic effect on small businesses or micro-businesses as a result of enforcing the section. Therefore, no regulatory flexibility analysis is required. There is no anticipated economic cost to persons who are required to comply with the section as proposed. Mr. Cutter has also determined that for each year of the first five years the proposed section is in
 effect there should be no effect on a local economy, and therefore no local employment impact
 statement is required under Administrative Procedure Act (APA), Texas Government Code
 §2001.022.

5 The commission staff will conduct a public hearing on this rulemaking, if requested pursuant to 6 the Administrative Procedure Act, Texas Government Code §2001.029, at the commission's 7 offices located in the William B. Travis Building, 1701 North Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 8 78711. The request for a public hearing must be received within 20 days after publication.

9 Initial comments on the amendment may be submitted to the Filing Clerk, Public Utility 10 Commission of Texas, 1701 North Congress Avenue, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-11 3326, within 20 days after publication. Reply comments may be submitted within 27 days after 12 publication. Sixteen copies of comments and replies on the amendment are required to be filed 13 pursuant to §22.71(c) of this title. Comments should be organized in a manner consistent with 14 the organization of the amended rule. All comments should refer to Project Number 41747.

This amendment is proposed under the Public Utility Regulatory Act, Texas Utilities Code Annotated §14.002 (PURA), which provides the Public Utility Commission with the authority to make and enforce rules reasonably required in the exercise of its powers and jurisdiction; and specifically, HB 994, which amends PURA §39.206(a)(3) and (b), effective May 18, 2013, by extending the time period during which construction of a nuclear generating unit shall be started in order for the terms that are established in §25.304 to apply to its decommissioning trust.
