COMMISSION STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff (“Staff”) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“Commission”), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On August 15, 2013, Oncor Electric Delivery Company, LLC (“Oncor”) filed a compliance tariff for the annual true up of its TC1 charges per the Financing Order issued on August 5, 2002, in Docket No. 25230, *Joint Application for Approval of Stipulation Regarding TXU Electric Company Transition to Competition Issues*.

On August 16, 2013, a notice was entered requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the compliance filing or propose a procedural schedule, if necessary. This pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed Oncor’s filing and, based on the attached memorandum from Grant Gervais of the Commission’s Rate Regulation Division, recommends adoption of Oncor’s proposed rider as filed. Additionally, staff recommends that a “clean” record of Rider TC1, pages 8 through 14 of Attachment 7 to Oncor’s application, be stamped “Approved” by the Commission’s Central Records Division and retained for future reference.

On August 15, 2013, Oncor Electric Delivery Company (“Oncor”) filed for an annual true-up of *Rider TC1- Transition Charge*, Section 6.1.1.2.1 of its tariff (“Rider TC1”) in compliance with the Financing Order of August 5, 2002, in Docket Number 25230. Oncor is required to file an annual Standard True-up to correct for any over- or under- collections and ensure sufficient billings of transition charges to provide for all scheduled payments of principal, interest, and other amounts related to the transition bonds.

Oncor states that as of July 31, 2013, it had over-collected its total transition charges by \$458,493.36, with some rate classes in a position of over-collection, and some in under-collection. Effective August 30, 2013, Oncor has adjusted the transition charge rates in Rider TC1 to reflect these over- and under-collections, as well as the current requirements to service its bonds.

Staff has reviewed Oncor’s filing and determined that the update to Rider TC1 is accurate and reflects the necessary adjustments to correct the over- and under-collected amounts. Staff therefore recommends that Oncor’s proposed *Rider TC1-Transition Charge, Tariff Rate Schedule 6.1.1.2.1, Revision No. 13* be **adopted** as filed on August 15, 2013. Additionally, staff recommends that a “clean” record of Rider TC1, pages 8 through 14 of Attachment 7 to Oncor’s application, be stamped “Approved” by the Commission’s Central Records Division and retained for future reference.
