Please refer to Schedule G-14.1, as well as the Application at page 7, which indicate that the Company seeks recovery in the Rate Case Expense Rider of \$9,374,854 in costs incurred subsequent to September 30, 2012, in relation to the rate case filing in PUC Docket No. 39896, the associated rate case expense proceeding PUC Docket No. 40295, and the estimated costs the company will incur with this rate case filing.

- a. Actual costs for which the Company is seeking recovery in Docket Nos. 39896 and 40295 through March 31, 2013 but subsequent to September 30, 2012 amount to \$474,314. The estimated costs for Docket No. 41791 are \$8.9 million. Both are shown on Schedule G-14-1.
