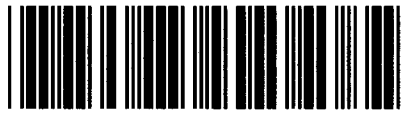

Please consider my objection to the above proposed project. Frisco is a well-planned community and the proposal undermines all of the work that has been set forth in the western part of this city.

Brazos Electric is rushing into this project with no regard to the following items:

The lines are not immediately necessary. There is no rush as projections indicate that the current lines in the area will only be at 73% capacity by the year 2018. There is certainly time for Brazos to propose better alternatives such as ...

- Using existing utility lines and corridors
- Using Army Corps of Engineers land that will never be developed
- Routing these around so much population density
- And the best option of all - BURYING THE LINES

Eastern Denton County is an extremely sought after area and these lines as proposed will adversely affect over 35,000 residents' property values and threatens the growing tax base.

The proposal will limit green space and present a monumental eye sore.

City ordinances in place call for the lines to be buried.
