Dear Chairman Nelson,

I am writing you because I disagree with the planned Brazos Electric transmission line and substation expansion project planned for Frisco, TX. While I am but one of thousands of residents against this proposed plan, I feel we all have much more to lose if this is approved.

First off, thousands of residents who already own homes in the proposed impact area will automatically receive a reduction of 20 percent in home value from these towering 120 foot tall high voltage power lines. I hope the commission also understands the EMF considerations to the public and environment specifically children during their growing years.

We chose to move here to escape many of the high voltage power lines that are allowed to exist elsewhere. We love the fact that the City of Frisco is a safe city that was concerned enough to require these lines be buried for aesthetic and health reasons.
