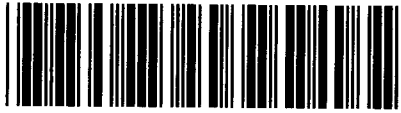

I am writing to formally oppose Brazos Electric's proposed transmission lines and a substation for Main Street and Stonebrook Parkway in Frisco, TX. Frisco is a beautiful city and our leaders have given much thought and care in the development of our city. It is because of this that we are currently one of the fastest growing cities in the country. Do you want to be a part of destroying this or be a part of "Keeping Frisco Beautiful?" This Eastern part of Denton County is a crown jewel of Texas and if this proposal goes through it has the potential to impact over 35,000 residents' property values and threaten our growing tax base. This does not include the impact this will have on Frisco's business community. It is hard to believe that anyone would even consider putting a substation and 12 story high transmission towers in such a densely populated area.

I am also concerned about the lack of thought, planning, and transparency that has gone into Brazos' proposal. They need to demonstrate a need for a new 138,000-volt transmission line. If they are unable to use existing infrastructure then the lines should be buried in accordance with the City of Frisco Ordinances.

I encourage you as our chairman along with your Commissioners to do the right thing for Frisco! I also ask that all public hearings on this issue be conducted in Frisco to accommodate the many residents who will want to speak on this important issue.
