Dear Sir,

I am writing in strong opposition to the planned Brazos Electric transmission line and substation expansion project planned for the Stonebrook Parkway area of Frisco, Texas.

An initial plan and application was submitted by Brazos to use Army Corps of Engineers land and was denied, requiring Brazos to look at other routes. The proposed routes are not viable and threaten an extreme risk to existing residents' health and property values. The four (4) schools, Elementary through High School, will be lined with the transmission lines and our children's entire schooling will take place in this area with constant exposure to dangerous electromagnetic fields. In addition, our home values have the potential to decline almost 20%, according to local realtors. This will also have a negative impact on our tax revenue collected by the City of Frisco, Denton County, and Frisco ISD, not to mention residents' personal loss in home value.

As a resident directly impacted by the Brazos electric plan, I request your immediate action in, first, urging the Army Corps of Engineers to allow Brazos access to Corps property to install the transmission lines and substation. We ask that you request the Army Corps to work with Brazos in finding a viable option not to include impacting existing residents and their families. This electric plan is moving forward and we need your action and assistance now in our endeavor to prevent Stonebrook Parkway from housing these unsightly, and hazardous lines.
