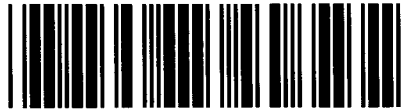

**ORDER NO. 2
ADOPTING REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On May 12, 2014, Grande Communications Networks, LLC (Grande or Applicant) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) for approval to amend its State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority (SICFA) No. 90002. Applicant stated that it seeks to expand its service area footprint to include the Platinum Castle Hills Apartments within the city limits of Lewisville in Denton County.

On May 16, 2014, Grande filed a corrected application for amendment of SICFA No. 90002. The amended application describes two areas requested for expansion of service area footprint which was not apparent in the original application. The amended application states that Applicant seeks to expand its service area footprint to include the following:

1. The municipal boundaries of the city of The Colony; and
2. Within McLennan County:
 - a. A suburb of the Waco Metropolitan Statistical Area known as Speegleville. The community is located along Texas State Highway 6 around eight miles to the west of the City of Waco on the western edge of Lake Waco.
 - b. A suburb of the Waco Metropolitan Statistical Area known as China Springs located in the Northwestern part of McLennan County along Farm Road 1637 twelve miles northwest of the City of Waco.

Because the amended application covers a broader service area footprint not described in the original application, additional *Texas Register* notice is required. Thus a new procedural schedule is necessary.

I. Procedural Schedule

The following revised procedural schedule is adopted based on the filing date of the amended application and shall apply in this project:

Filing date	May 16, 2014
Commission requests <i>Texas Register</i> to announce application	May 16, 2014
Commission Staff files recommendation re: sufficiency/approval	June 2, 2014
<i>Texas Register</i> publication	May 30, 2014 ¹
If application is found insufficient, Commission issues order and resets the procedural schedule	June 6, 2014
Order to approve or dismiss application	June 10, 2014

II. Procedures

The Commission's procedural rules apply in this docket, unless otherwise specified. The Commission's rules are available at: www.puc.texas.gov.

A. Filing

All pleadings must state the project number assigned to this proceeding. Parties shall file seven (7) copies of all pleadings. All documents must be filed by 3:00 p.m. on the date due unless otherwise ordered.

B. Service

A copy of documents filed with the Commission must be served on all parties according to P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.74.

¹ The procedural schedule adopted in Order No. 1 depicts June 2, 2014 as the date for *Texas Register* publication. This is incorrect. The correct date for publication of notice in the *Texas Register* of the original application is May 23, 2014. Publication of notice of the amended application will be on May 30, 2014.
