## SOAH ORDER NO. 6 GRANTING MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND **REMAND TO COMMISSION**

On September 5, 2014, AEP Texas Central Company (TCC) filed a motion to admit evidence in support of a stipulation and to remand the settled case to the Texas Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission). TCC indicates that Commission Staff and Cities Served by the AEP Texas Central Company (Cities) have entered into a stipulation that resolves all issues. As there are no longer any contested issues, the motion is GRANTED.

The following evidence is admitted into the record:

- > TCC's application, filed May 30, 2014, and all attachments, testimony, schedules, and workpapers;
- > Proof of notice, filed June 2, 2014;
- > Cities' affidavit, filed July 25, 2014;
- > Cities' testimony, filed August 1, 2014;
- > Staff affidavits, filed September 5, 2014; and
- > Stipulation and attachments, filed September 5, 2014.<sup>2</sup>

This case is dismissed from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and remanded to the Commission for final processing.
