Dear Shana:

Your registration as a Pay Telephone Service Provider has been received and processed by the Public Utility Commission of Texas.

This letter constitutes proof of registration to provide pay telephone service in Texas. Retain this letter for your records, as a copy must be provided to the carrier that will connect your service to the network. Your permanent tracking number, which should be included with any correspondence or submissions to the Commission relating to pay telephone service, is **PP011584**.

<u>To retain your registration, you must reregister annually with the Commission by July 31 of each</u> <u>calendar year</u>. A Pay Telephone Service Provider that fails to reregister will be removed from the list of registered providers posted on the PUC web site under Utility Directories and is subject to disconnection. Rereregistration information is posted on the Commission's web site under Industry – Communications – Registration & Reporting: <u>http://www.puc.state.tx.us/industry/communications/business/pp/pp.aspx</u> You are advised to monitor this site for any changes in the rules, required form, and re-registration process.

Within 30 days of receiving this letter, you must file in Central Records an original and three copies of your list of telephone numbers and county locations if you have not already done so. If you have more than 5 payphone numbers, two (2) identical CDs are required and must be labeled with the name of the company and the project number, which is 42669, in the following format. The first column should be the 10 digit number and the second column should be the county name. Tab once between the telephone number and the county (NO SPACES) and save as an <u>EXCEL file ONLY</u>. You must also supply a copy of your placard which has the address and phone number of the contact for repairs and reimbursements.

Pay telephone service in Texas is governed by statute, regulation, and tariff. Tariffs are established by the local exchange carrier or carriers that serve your pay telephone(s). Applicable tariffs can be obtained from your local provider. The statutes are: The Public Utility Regulatory Act of 1999 (PURA) and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. The Commission's substantive rules governing pay telephone service are: §26.102 and 26.341 – 26.347.
