On April 1, 2013, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your application to amend a CCN in Montgomery and Liberty Counties and accepted it for filing on June 28, 2013. TCEQ received a protest from Russell & Rodriguez, L.L.P. representing the City of Patton Village.
