The Applicant offered its jurisdictional documents, Applicant's Exhibits 1-3. There were no objections and Applicant's Exhibits 1-3 were admitted. Therefore, the ALJ finds that Applicant's notice of its application is sufficient and complies with P.U.C. Subst. R. 24.106.
