JOINT MOTION TO ABATE

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), the City of Splendora (Splendora), and the City of Patton Village (Patton Village) and files this Joint Motion to Abate, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On April 1, 2013, the City of Splendora filed an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery and Liberty Counties. On April 14, 2015, the SOAH Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued SOAH Order No. 8, which referred this proceeding to mediation. On May 29, 2015, mediation was held at the SOAH offices in Houston which included Splendora, Patton Village, and Staff.

II. MOTION TO ABATE


Splendora and Patton Village have reached an agreement-in-principle at the mediation that would resolve Patton Village's protest of the application. The parties request that the proceeding be abated for 45 days to finalize and carry out the obligations contained in such agreement, which include, but are not limited to, Splendora amending its water CCN application and Patton Village withdrawing its protest of such application, as amended. Staff is authorized to represent that Splendora and Patton Village join this motion. The parties will file a status report or an updated procedural schedule no later than July 16, 2015 if the agreement is not finalized by that time.


