## ORDER NO. 20 RESETTING THE HEARING ON THE MERITS AND ISSUING AN AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULING

On September 18, 2014, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC/Commission) filed a joint proposed procedural schedule that included three dates for resetting the hearing on the merits. The ALJ has reset the hearing on the merits to begin on the agreed date of March 10, 2015, and continue through March 12, 2015, if necessary. The ALJ further approved the proposed procedural schedule as set forth below.

## I. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

October 17, 2014	Deadline to propound any discovery.
November 14, 2014	Deadline for Double Diamond Utilities Co. to file direct testimony.
December 12, 2014	Deadline for Northwest Grayson Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 to file direct testimony.
January 30, 2015	Deadline for PUC Staff to file direct testimony or statement of position.
February 13, 2015	Deadline for all parties to file rebuttal testimony
February 23, 2015	Deadline to file written objections to prefiled testimony.
March 3, 2015	Deadline to file responses to written objections.
TBD, if necessary	Final Prehearing Conference
March 10-12, 2015	Hearing on merits.

The parties are **ORDERED** to comply with this procedural schedule. Except for the hearing on the merits, the parties may modify the schedule by written agreement. The hearing on the merits can only be changed by an order from the ALJ.

The procedural rules of the PUC, chapter 22 of the PUC's rules, now govern this case. However, discovery that was propounded and responded to before September 1, 2014, remain subject to the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality's prior discovery rules.

## II. HEARING ON THE MERITS

The hearing on the merits will convene at 9:00 a.m., on March 10-12, 2015, in a hearing room at the State Office of Administrative Hearing (SOAH) in the William P. Clements Jr. Building, 300 W. 15th Street, 4th Floor, Austin, Texas. Because the hearing will last longer than a day, the hearing must be transcribed by a court reporter. Individuals who do not have a state-issued identification badge should be prepared to register with a security guard on the first floor of the building. Having the docket number of the case and a photo identification card will expedite the registration.
