STATUS REPORT

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

Double Diamond Utilities Co. ("DDU") files this Status Report pursuant to Order No. 8

BACKGROUND

A preliminary hearing in the above-captioned matter was held on May 8, 2008. In Order Number 1, the ALJ memorialized the preliminary hearing in which she took jurisdiction; designated parties; and established a procedural schedule. On August 13, 2008, DDU and Northwest Grayson County WCID No. 1 (the "District") filed a joint motion to abate this proceeding, and all related deadlines, for sixty (60) days. Thereafter, along with submitting status reports, additional requests for the extension of the abatement period were submitted and approved by the ALJ as set out in Order Nos. 5, 6, and 7. On April 21, 2010, DDU filed an Unopposed Motion to Extend Abatement for an additional six months. On April 26, 2010, the ALJ issued Order No. 8 granting this motion and abating the matter until October 21, 2010. The ALJ requested the submittal of a status report every 60 days.

STATUS REPORT


The parties have exchanged settlement offers and discussions are ongoing. Most recently, DDU sent the District a settlement proposal on June 9, 2010 and is awaiting a response


