## JOINT AND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Northwest Grayson Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 ("District"), Double Diamond Utilities Co. ("DDU"), the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and the Public Interest Counsel and files this *Joint and Unopposed Motion for Continuance* and in support thereof would show the following:

Order No. 13 in this cause set out a procedural schedule that culminated in a Hearing on the merits to be held on February 25-27, 2014. DDU and the District have worked toward a settlement and they believe that they are close to a settlement of all issues. In the spirit of settlement, no party in this proceeding has served on the other any discovery in the hopes of reducing litigation costs and to not distract them from settling.

Recently, settlement talks have been delayed. The District's consulting engineer has been unable to consult with the District with the same frequency as in the past as his mother has had health problems that has resulted in her being in hospice care. Due to these unfortunate circumstances, the District only recently has been able to resume settlement discussions with DDU.

Because of the delay in the settlement discussions, the District, DDU, and the Executive Director of the TCEQ hereby request a continuance of all deadlines in this matter. The parties will work toward a new procedural schedule and anticipate that said schedule will be submitted within the next week. The motion is not sought for delay, but so that justice may be served. The Public Interest Counsel does not oppose this motion.

## PRAYER

Based on the foregoing, the District respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge grant the motion for continuance as discussed herein. The District asks for any such further relief to which it has shown itself to be justly entitled.
