PREFILED TESTIMONY OF DAVID WRIGHT

- 1 Q. Please state your name and business address for the record.
- 2 A. I am David Wright. My business address is TNG Utility Corp., 2815 Spring Cypress
- 3 Rd. #3, Spring Texas 77388.

- 5 Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
- 6 A. I am the Vice President and General Manager of TNG.

7

- 8 Q. What is your relationship with the applicant, Douglas Utility Company (Douglas)?
- 9 A. TNG operates the water and wastewater plant in Douglas' certificated service area.
- 10 We also do their meter reading and billing and some customer services. As General
- 11 Manager, I am responsible for this work.

- 13 Q. What is your background in the water/sewer utility industry that makes you
- 14 qualified to perform these duties?
- 15 A. I have been in the water industry the majority of my life, working at Hays Utility
- 16 Service for 25 years since I was 18 years old. I have obtained double B licenses in water
- 17 and wastewater operations from the state of Texas and am a licensed Master Plumber. I
- worked as a laborer, operator, equipment operator, operations manager, and construction
- 19 manager while at Hays Utility. I have attended hundreds of hours of TCEQ-approved
- training in all aspects of public utilities. I am a co-founder and now the General Manager
- 21 at TNG Utility and currently serve on the AWBD Water Smart committee. I have served
- as a director for Harris County MUD 82 for 12 years and Harris County MUD 407 for 5
- 23 years.



PREFILED TESTIMONY OF DAVID WRIGHT

- 1 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this rate case?
- 2 A. I will address the effect that the pre-application, contemplated settlement and
- 3 proposed rates would have on Douglas' financial integrity.

4

- 5 Q. How to you define "financial integrity"?
- 6 A. "Financial integrity" to me means the ability to collect sufficient water/sewer
- 7 revenues to pay all of the utility's operating costs and taxes with sufficient additional
- 8 revenues to allow for capital investment through depreciation expense coverage and
- 9 allow the utility a reasonable opportunity to service debt and/or earn a profit for the
- 10 owner(s).

11

- 12 Q. Does Douglas have a financial integrity?
- 13 A. Yes, although that financial integrity has been deteriorating under the pre-
- 14 application rates. Douglas is a privately owned business. It has no debt at this time but
- will when it draws down the bank loan to rehabilitate the sewer plant. To preserve its
- 16 financial integrity, it must have rates that will generate a positive cash flow. If the rates
- 17 charged do not do this then the utility's financial integrity declines or is wiped out.

- 19 Q. Have you done an analysis of what various levels of rates will do to Douglas'
- 20 financial integrity?
- 21 A. Yes. It is attached to my prefiled testimony as "David Wright Schedule A."

22

23 Q. How do you read David Wright Schedule A?

PREFILED TESTIMONY OF DAVID WRIGHT

- 1 A. The Schedule assumes that Douglas has the revenue requirements identified in
- 2 the testimony of Douglas witness Ronald Payne. There is a summary page of the
- 3 revenues that would be generated to cover the revenue requirements followed by 8
- 4 computational sheets that the summary is based on.

5

- 6 Q. Looking at the summary page, what does David Wright Schedule A show?
- 7 A. It shows that under both the pre-application rates and the contemplated settlement
- 8 rates Douglas would have a negative cash flow and could not meet its financial
- 9 obligations. Under the proposed rates, Douglas will cover its operating costs, taxes, etc.
- and earn a profit which can be used to fund the sewer plant rehabilitation.

- 12 Q. What does this mean for Douglas' "financial integrity"?
- 13 A. Under the pre-application and contemplated settlement rates Douglas' financial
- 14 integrity declines and is not preserved. Under the proposed rates, Douglas' financial
- 15 integrity is strengthen and is preserved

16

- 17 Q. Does this conclude your testimony?
- 18 A. Yes, it does.
