The Town of Woodloch is in the process of improving both the water and wastewater facilities. Water conservation is a high priority for all users in Montgomery County. The Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District [LSGCD] required all large volume users to submitted a Groundwater Reduction Plan [GRP] detailing how to reduce ground water use. The Town of Woodloch submitted a GRP detailing how we would accomplish that through water accountability, addressing water leaks, and water conservation measures. The steps we are taking involve upgrading our water system with a new ground storage tank and new water lines. The current ground storage tank is over 15 years old and was used when constructed. Repairs have been made over the years, but it is now critical that a new tank be constructed. The Town of Woodloch is seeking a loan for the construction of this new tank. The current tank will remain, repairs made, and used as a backup for the new tank. Plans have been drawn, vendor selected and the tank should be on site this summer.

The Town of Woodloch has submitted a loan application to the Texas Water Development Board [TWDB] for the construction of a new concrete wastewater treatment plant. In addition, new force mains will be constructed along North and South Woodloch. These force mains collect sewage from the entire service area and sends it to the treatment plant. The current treatment plant was erected in 1994, and was obtained from the Richey Road Utility District. It is time for a new plant.

The loan from the TWDB will be in the amount of \$1.9 million dollars. As we are a low-to-moderate income community, we are eligible for up to 70% forgiveness. The loan from the bank will be in the amount of \$150,000. We have obtained grants for as much rehabilitation and new construction projects as possible. These grants were always capped at \$350,000. Our current needs far exceed grant limits. Therefore, loans are being procured to make necessary improvements and new construction.

Loans have to be paid back. Over the past six months, Council has worked with our engineer, our financial advisor, and obtained legal counsel to evaluate our current water and sewer rates. While we will continue to apply for grants, our current needs necessitate loans. In order to meet the loan requirements, new rates were established and voted on January 18, 2013 meeting, effective February 25, 2013. A copy of the new fee schedule is attached.

Since 1994, the Town of Woodloch has applied for, and received over \$1.6 million in grants for improvements to the water and wastewater facilities. In addition, a \$300,000 loan was obtained to make major improvements and new construction. These improvements were

necessary to continue providing quality water and exceptional services to this area.

The improvements made in our service area include:

• In the Woodhollow area: 1) Two new lift stations

2) New water lines

• In the River Oaks area: 1) Rehabilitation of existing lift station

2) New sewer lines

• In the River Ridge area: 1) New lift station

2) New water lines with fire hydrants

• Facilities: 1) Improvements to the wastewater treatment plant

2) Improvements to the water plant3) Additional hydro-pneumatic tank

4)Construction of municipal building housing

administrative and public works offices

We will continue to seek grants for future improvements. As stated above, the facility construction needs far exceed grant amount limits. The new facilities will replace old structures which are in dire need of replacement, and provide continued service for many years to come.

Re: New Water Conservation Rules and Fee Schedules

Dear Citizens:

Much has been said in the news about the pending crisis concerning water availability from the aquifer serving everyone in Montgomery County and the requirement for local water suppliers throughout the County to find alternative sources for water consumption. In June 2001, the State Legislature created the Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (LSGCD) with its primary responsibility to develop and implement a strategy that requires a reduction in groundwater consumption to preserve our aquifer for future generations.

Throughout Montgomery County, municipalities and other Large Volume Groundwater Users (LVGU) just like Woodloch are being required by the LSGCD to reduce their water consumption by 30%. The San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) has assumed the challenge of developing a county-wide groundwater reduction plan for all participating LVGUs through supplementation with surface water primarily from Lake Conroe as the alternate water supply that will provide a regional solution to achieve compliance efficiently and with less cost. This will ensure the aquifer is not depleted while sustaining our rapid population growth and economic development.

Since the SJRA is not a taxing entity, funding for the future water supply and improvements to the infrastructure can only be obtained through the sale of revenue bonds which are repaid by groundwater pumpage fees assessed to all customers of LVGUs throughout the County. The Town of Woodloch will necessarily be one of the LVGUs that is assessed this fee.

Starting with your August 2010 water bill, you will be assessed a "pass through" SJRA pumpage fee for each 1,000 gallons of water used by you, the customer. This water rate increase will fund the purchase of available surface water as well as the operation and maintenance of the entire SJRA water delivery system for all users throughout the County.

To Water and Sewer Customers

A new water and sewer ordinance was approved January 18, 2013. As stated in the letter sent to all customers, this increase was needed to construct a new more efficient and quieter wastewater treatment and sewer mains. In addition, a new ground water storage tank was needed as the current tank was over 30 years old and unreliable, and new electronic meters were installed. In April and May of 2013, the Town of Woodloch received two petitions protesting the water and sewer rate increase from Outside City Ratepayers.. The petitions came from the residents of the Hickory Ridge and Oak Forest Subdivisions.

The initial hearing was in August, 2013 in Austin, Texas. At that time, the following individuals were elected to represent their respective areas, or individual(s):

- 1. Catherine Lewkowski Lead Representative [representing only herself]
- 2. David Bonham [representing residents of the Hickory Ridge Subdivision]
- 3. Miriam Gomez [representing residents of the Oak Forest Subdivision]

From August, 2013 to December, 2013, the Town of Woodloch met with the three representative to try and resolve the Rate Appeal. The Town of Woodloch offered the following options in order to reach a settlement:

- 1. Garbage collection for a monthly flat fee of \$16.00.
- 2. Reduced water and sewer rates overall.
- 3. Reduced water and sewer rates with a uniform \$30 monthly surcharge.

The three representatives refused all settlement offers. As a result, the Town of Woodloch was forced to retain attorneys, engineers, and experts to assist in this litigation, which has become very costly. To date, the Town of Woodloch has been burdened with over \$53,000.00 in Rate Appeal expenses. As the final hearing is not scheduled until September, 2014, Woodloch's expenses for this litigation will continue to rise until such time as the appeal is resolved.

In order to continue this litigation, the Town of Woodloch had no other option than to assess a surcharge on water and sewer bills to pay for the Rate Appeal costs. On Tuesday, June 10, 2014, the Woodloch City Council voted to amend the current water and sewer rate ordinance. This amendment provided for the levy of a \$35.00 monthly surcharge on water and sewer bills. This surcharge will continue until such time as all Rate Appeal costs, both current and future, are reimbursed. This surcharge will begin with the June 20, 2014 bill.

Because this litigation has been so costly and will continue until resolution, the Woodloch city council will be investigating the reduction and/or elimination of certain services, and charging for customer requests. These customer requests may include: the re-reading of a meter; investigating a sewer line backup; investigating the report of a water leak; providing printed reports of account activity. Customers will be notified as to what, and when, the changes made.
