

Dear Judge Walston:

On December 19, 2008, the Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received a request from the Town of Woodloch to modify the procedural schedule for this case. The ED would like to note that the Town was considering such a request as early as December 10th, as Mayor Diane Lincoln left me a message regarding a possible extension while I was out of town December 8th-10th. I spoke with her about the matter on December 11th, and hearing nothing more on the subject after that date, I assumed the Town was going to file its prefiled testimony on December 19th as required by Order No. 5. The ED did not receive the Town's request until 4:49 p.m. on December 19th, essentially eleven minutes before the Town's prefiled testimony was due. The ED hopes your Honor will take this information into account when determining how to rule on the Town's request.

If you do choose to grant the request, the ED requests that you adopt the following dates:


Deadline/Date	Activity
January 20, 2009	Town's prefiled testimony due.
February 10, 2009	Petitioners' and OPIC's prefiled testimony due.
February 27, 2009	ED's prefiled testimony due.
March 6, 2009	Objections to prefiled testimony due.
March 13, 2009	Responses to objections to prefiled testimony due.
March 20, 2009	Prehearing conference to rule on objections to prefiled testimony, etc. at 10 a.m.
April 13, 2009	Hearing on the merits.

This essentially moves the dates listed in Order No. 5 back a month but maintains the currently scheduled date for the hearing on the merits.


