

MEDIATED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

To avoid litigating the application by the Farmers Transport Inc. dba Enchanted Harbor Utility ("Applicant") for water rate / tariff changes before the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ" or "Commission") in a contested case hearing, Applicant, the Executive Director ("ED"), and the following ratepayers (collectively "Protestants"): Keith L. Smith, Anne Clark and Evelyn Saucier, mediated their dispute and agree to the following:

A. Applicant agrees to:

1) Seek final approval of the following water rates and tariff charges:

Base rate = \$59.00, which includes 3000 gallons Volume charge (over 3000 gallons) = \$6/1000 gallons tap fee reduced to \$200. reconnect fee reduced to \$375.

2) Seek final approval of a surcharge amount reduced to \$42.78, with received amounts to be escrowed with and supervised by the TCEQ. Applicant agrees that these proceeds may be used only for the capital improvement projects listed on the following chart. Any amounts collected which exceed what is necessary to complete these projects shall be refunded to customers.

- 3. Contingent upon Applicant securing 3rd party financing at a rate equal to or lower than 10% per annum, Applicant agrees to a December 31, 2016 deadline for completion of capital improvement projects funded by abovereferenced surcharge, and if Applicant fails to meet that deadline, surcharge collection must cease. However, should Applicant be unable to secure 3rd party financing at a rate equal to or lower than 10% per annum, Applicant agrees that collected surcharges would be spent on the capital improvement projects as accrued, and there would be no deadline for completion of the improvements.
- 4. The Executive Director has agreed to review how Enchanted Harbor Utility has allocated the surcharge amounts it has collected in 2014, and provide an opinion as to whether those collected amounts have been properly directed toward funding the specific list of capital improvement projects listed in Enchanted Harbor Utility's Application. Should the Executive Director determine that surcharge collections have exceeded that which has been properly spent on said capital improvements, the dollar amount of that differential shall be deposited by Enchanted Harbor Utility into its soon-to-becreated escrow account, as an initial principal deposit.

- B. The Applicant and the Protestants agree to:
 - 1. No refunds to customers (of difference between current rates and those which this Settlement establishes).
 - 2. No rate expense reimbursement.
 - 3. No restriction on Applicant's ability to file future rate applications.
 - 4. The customers reserve the right to protest and review any such future rate increases as provided by law.
 - 5. Parties agree that usage beginning after August 1, 2014 shall be subject to these settlement rates.
- C. In consideration of the provisions listed above and actions to be taken by Applicant, Protestants hereby agree to withdraw their protests, hearing requests, and hearing party status requests previously filed and sought on this matter, and have no objection to a remand request of this matter from State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH"). [The signed withdrawal is attached to this agreement and labeled "Attachment A"].
- D. This Agreement is a legal contract between Applicant and Protestants, is enforceable by either party against the other in a court of competent jurisdiction, and is effective as of the date the last party executes this Agreement.
- E. The ED participated in the mediation but is not a party to this Agreement. The ED has signed this Agreement only as witnesses to the Agreement. The ED acknowledges the review commitment in A.4.
