ORDER NO. 2 GRANTING MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

On July 1, 2014, West Travis County Public Utility Agency (WTCPUA) filed a motion for clarification of Order No. 1. No party opposes the motion, and the motion is granted.

As the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) ruled at the preliminary hearing held on June 11, 2014, the schedule set out in Order No. 1 governs only the first phase of this case (Phase 1), which concerns whether WTCPUA's protested wholesale rates adversely affect the public interest.¹ Should the Commission² determine that the public interest is affected and remand this case for a second phase hearing (Phase 2) concerning WTCPUA cost of service, the ALJ will adopt a separate schedule to govern that phase.

Additionally, the schedule should be modified to change the date of one of the prehearing conferences from April 12 to April 13, 2015. With that change, the Phase 1 schedule concerning whether the protested wholesale rates adversely affect the public interest is set out below.
