# CITY OF AUSTIN'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND PREHEARING CONFERENCE

#### TO THE HONROABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES:

COMES NOW, the City of Austin, (herein sometimes referred to as "City," "Austin" or "Respondent"), in the above styled and docketed wholesale water and wastewater rate appeal proceeding and serves this, its Motion for Extension of Time and Prehearing Conference.

#### I. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1. The City of Austin ("the City" or "Austin") was made party to this water rate petition in accordance with Order No. 1 Granting Motion to Continue Preliminary Hearing ("Order No. 1") on June 17, 2013.
- 2. On July 14, 2014, Austin witnesses Greg Meszaros, Bart Jennings, Drema Gross, Teresa Lutes, Michael Castillo, David Anders, Joseph Healy and Richard Giardina filed their Prefiled Testimony and Exhibits with the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") and the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC"). Each of the named parties in Order No. 1 were served a copy of the prefiled testimonies via electronic mail and regular United States mail.
- 3. On December 22, 2014, Petitioners filed their Objections to, Motion to Exclude and Motion to Strike Prefiled Testimony and Exhibits of Greg Meszaros, Bart Jennings, Drema Gross, Teresa Lutes, Michael Castillo, David Anders, Joseph Healy and Richard Giardina's Prefiled Testimony.
- 4. Petitioners filed extensive objections on December 22, 2014, generally objecting to every aspect of Austin's direct case, including the identification of the witnesses, the use of any contractual or public records, many of which were the same documents included in Petitioners' prefiled testimony, and which form the jurisdictional bases of this case. Consequently, many of the objections were made simply to burden and harass Austin and to require Austin to provide a response.

# II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND FOR PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Austin will provide its responses to Petitioners objections later today. However, the extensive nature of Petitioners' objections make it tedious and difficult to provide individual written responses to each evidentiary challenge. In light of the extensive holiday schedule from

December 22, 2014 through today, January 5, 2014, Austin requests the opportunity to supplement its responses with oral argument at the next prehearing conference. Austin requests a prehearing conference to be scheduled in the week of January 12, 2014 to consider objections and responses to prefiled testimony and other pending motions.

# III. RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, the City of Austin prays that the Administrative Law Judges grant this Motion for Extension of Time and for Prehearing Conference; and schedule a prehearing conference for the week of January 12, 2014.
