ORDER NO. 1
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE;
AND REQUIRING AGREED PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 5, 2014, San Antonio River Authority (SARA) and W&W Water, Inc. (W&W) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of W&W's purchase of the Creekwood Estates Water System and the Seven Oaks Subdivision Water System (collectively, Facilities). This transaction includes the transfer of SARA's certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights to the Facilities. The Facilities are located in Wilson County.

The Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) has jurisdiction over this application pursuant to §§ 13.001 and 13.301 of the Texas Water Code.

Requiring Comments on Sufficiency of Application and Notice. Not later than September 19, 2014, Commission Staff shall file comments on the sufficiency of the application, including the sufficiency of the proposed notice and whether additional notice is required to comply with the applicable procedural rules. The Commission will provide notice of this joint application for publication in the *Texas Register*.

Requiring Agreed Proposed Procedural Schedule. Not later than September 19, 2014, the parties shall file a joint proposed procedural schedule, including deadlines for (1) affidavits evidencing proof of notice; (2) intervention; (3) discovery; (4) requests for referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings for a hearing on the merits, if necessary; (5) Commission Staff's recommendation; and (6) Applicant's response to Commission Staff's recommendation or, in the alternative, a settlement of all issues, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, and proposed ordering paragraphs.
