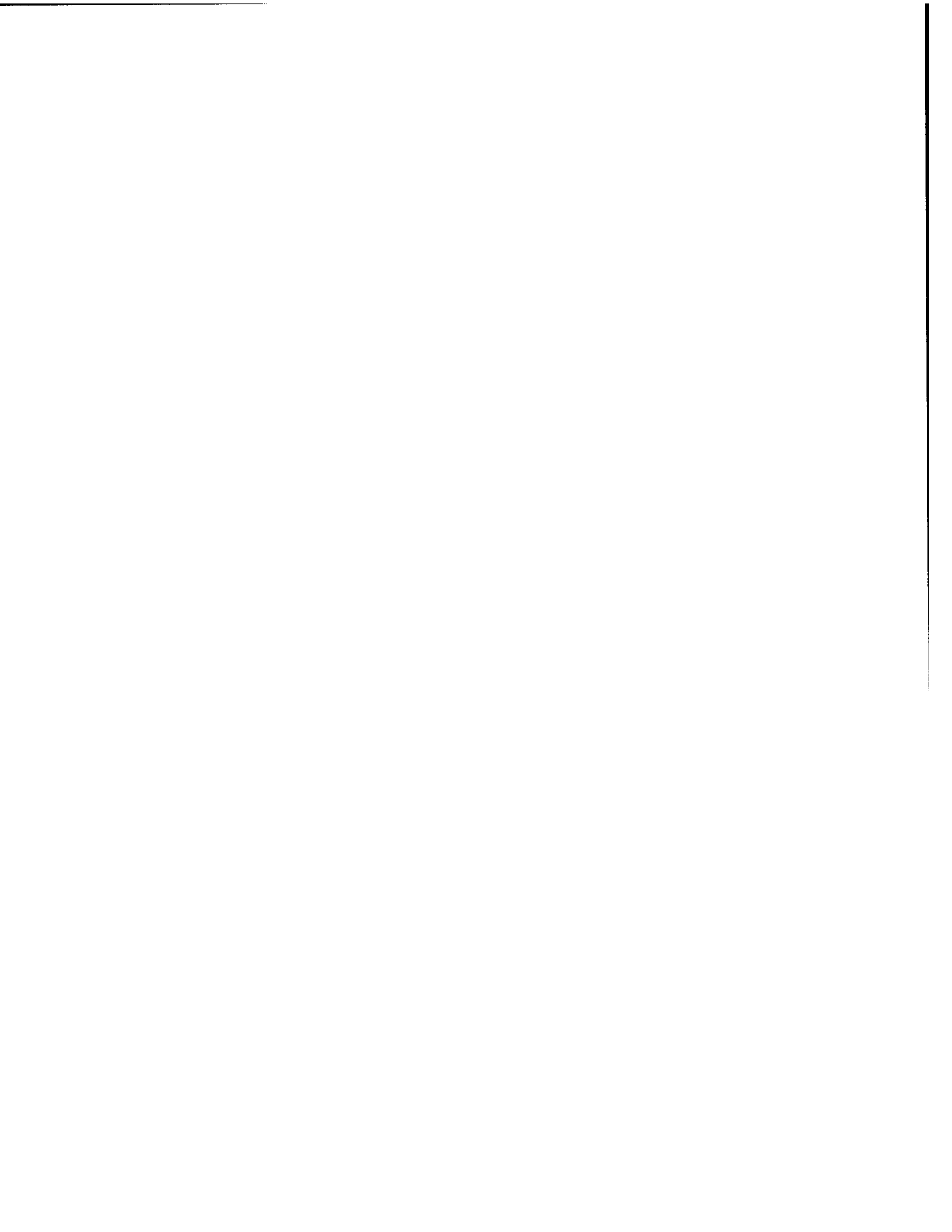



Double Diamond Utilities, Inc. (DDU), the investor-owned, retail public water and sewer utility operating under state issued certificates of convenience and necessity provides retail water and wastewater utility service to property owners residing in The Retreat residential development (The Retreat) in Johnson County, Texas. On October 15, 2013, DDU filed a water rate/tariff change application (Application No. 37752-R) and a sewer rate/tariff change application (Application No. 37753-R) with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). The TCEQ is the regulatory authority under Texas Water Code § 13.042(e) having original jurisdiction over the water and sewer rates of DDU within The Retreat.
