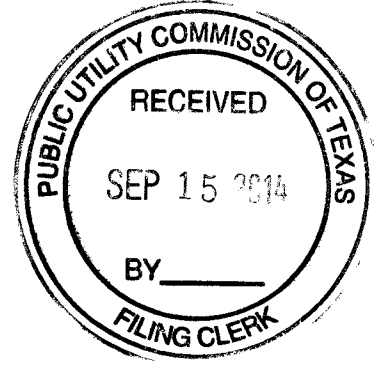



On October 15, 2013, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your applications for a Water and Sewer Rate/Tariff changes for the above referenced utility.
