On October 15, 2013, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your applications for a Water and Sewer Rate/Tariff changes for the above referenced utility. The TCEQ has received 39 protests from a total of 86 customers, which is more than ten percent (10%) of your affected customers.
