ORDER NO. 7 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Background

On July 10, 2015, Order No. 6 was issued in this proceeding, requiring Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) and Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District 1 (Lakeside WCID 1) (collectively the Applicants) to provide additional information regarding this application. On July 31, 2015, Lakeside WCID 1 filed supplemental documents to cure the deficiencies in the initial application.

II. Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On September 1, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed comments on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application remains deficient and is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's September 1, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Mary Lupo and Tracy Harbour, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Applicants should not publish notice of the application until these discrepancies are corrected and approved by Staff.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until October 1, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file by November 2,

2015, additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Lakeside WCID 1 and Manville WSC's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **October 1**, **2015**, Applicants shall amend this application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before November 2, 2015, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
