In my opinion, the WCID 1 has demonstrated adequate financial and managerial capability to provide service to the area contracted for release and transfer. These conclusions are based on information provided by the applicants prior to this date and may not reflect any changes in the applicants' status subsequent to this date.

#### **Background**

Tiemann Land & Cattle Development Inc. and Manville Water Supply Corporation entered an agreement as of October 07, 1996 to transfer a portion of CCN No. 11144 as a benefit of Lakeside WCID 1 at a future date. After other assignments and agreements, a water utility service area agreement was entered into between the City of Pflugerville and Lakeside WCIDs # 1, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D to execute the initial transfer of the agreement cited above. This water utility service agreement was executed on August 16, 2013 and will transfer approximately 166.19 acres of overlapping boundary area and no facilities from Manville WSC's CCN 11144 to the Lakeside WCID 1.

Lakeside WCID 1 has provided water service to more than 561 connections as well as pumped 71,964,400 gallons and billed 71,964,400 gallons per their audited financial statements ending September 30, 2013. An unqualified opinion was issued for these statements indicating they represent fairly the financial position of Lakeside WCID 1 in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles. Per the terms of the final agreement no compensation is required for the transfer of the CCN area. As of September 30, 2013 Lakeside WCID 1 reported unassigned equity of \$1.2 million and a total cash amount of \$1.3 million. The change in net position for Lakeside WCID 1 increased by \$20 thousand for FY2013. Lakeside WCID 1 additionally reported total revenues in excess of expenditures of \$240 thousand and the total assets of \$1.6 million before adjustments for FY2013 as well.

#### 2. Cash and Investments (continued)

Public Funds Investment Pools – Public funds investment pools in Texas ("Pools") are established under the authority of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 79 of the Texas Government Code, and are subject to the provisions of the Public Funds Investment Act (the "Act"), Chapter 2256 of the Texas Government Code. In addition to other provisions of the Act designed to promote liquidity and safety of principal, the Act requires Pools to: 1) have an advisory board composed of participants in the Pool and other person who do not have a business relationship with the Pool and are qualified to advise the Pool; 2) maintain a continuous rating of no lower than AAA or AAA-m or an equivalent rating by at least on nationally recognized rating service; and 3) maintain the market value of its underlying investment portfolio with one half of one percent of the value of its shares.

The District's investments in Pools are reported at an amount determined by the fair value per share of the Pool's underling portfolio, unless the Pool is 2a7-like, in which case they are reported at share value. A 2a7-like Pool is one which is not registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") as an investment company, but nevertheless has a policy that it will, and does, operate in a manner consistent with the SEC's Rule 2a7 of the Investment Company Act of 1940.

#### 3. Property Taxes

Property taxes are considered available when collected within the current period or expected to be collected soon enough thereafter to be used to pay liabilities of the current period. The District levies its taxes on October 1 in conformity with Subtitle E, Texas Property Tax Code. Taxes are due upon receipt of the tax bill and are past due and subject to interest if not paid by February 1 of the year following the October 1 levy date. The assessed value of the property tax roll on January 1, 2012, upon which the levy for the 2012-13 fiscal year was based, was \$111,157,757. Taxes are delinquent if not paid by June 30. Delinquent taxes are subject to both penalty and interest charges plus delinquent collection fees for attorney costs.

The tax rates assessed for the year ended September 30, 2013, to finance General Fund operations and the payment of principal and interest on general obligation long-term debt were \$0.46 and \$0.42 per \$100 valuation, respectively, for a total of \$0.88 per \$100 valuation.

Current tax collections for the year ended September 30, 2013 were 99.97% of the year end adjusted tax levy. Delinquent taxes are prorated between maintenance and debt service based on rates adopted for the year of the levy. The District is prohibited from writing off real property taxes without specific statutory authority from the Texas Legislature. As of September 30, 2013, property taxes receivable, totaled \$149 and \$148 for the General and Debt Service Funds, respectively.

#### 2. Cash and Investments (continued)

Credit Risk – Credit risk is the risk that an issuer or other counterparty to an investment will not fulfill its obligations. The ratings of securities by nationally recognized rating agencies are designed to give an indication of credit risk. At year end, the District was not significantly exposed to credit risk.

At year end, the District's investments, other than those which are obligations of or guaranteed by the US Government, are rated as to credit quality as follows:

TexPool Rating AAA-m

Custodial Credit Risk — Deposits are exposed to custodial credit risk if they are not covered by depository insurance and the deposits are uncollateralized, collateralized with securities held by the pledging financial institution, or collateralized with securities held by the pledging financial institution's trust department or agent but not in the District's name.

Investment securities are exposed to custodial credit risk if the securities are uninsured, are not registered in the name of the government, and are held by either the counterpart or the counterparty's trust department or agent but not in the District's name. At year end, the District was not exposed to custodial credit risk.

Concentration of Credit Risk – This risk is the risk of loss attributed to the magnitude of a government's investment in a single issuer. At year end, the District was not exposed to concentration of credit risk.

Interest Rate Risk — This is the risk that changes in interest rates will adversely affect the fair value of an investment. At year end, the District was not exposed to interest rate risk.

Foreign Currency Risk - This is the risk that exchange rates will adversely affect the fair value of an investment. At year end, the District was not exposed to foreign currency risk.

Investment Accounting Policy – The District's general policy is to report money market investments and short-term participating interest-earning investment contracts at amortized cost and to report nonparticipating interest-earning investment contracts using a cost-based measure. However, if the fair value of an investment is significantly affected by the impairment of the credit standing of the issuer or by other factors, it is reported at fair value. All other investments are reported at fair value unless a legal contract exists which guarantees a higher value. The term "short-term" refers to investments which have a remaining term of one year or less at time of purchase. The term "nonparticipating" means that the investment's value does not vary with market interest rate changes. Nonnegotiable certificates of deposit are examples of nonparticipating interest-earning investment contracts.

#### 4. Capital Assets

During the year, the District acquired additional Water, Wasterwater and Drainage Facilities serving the District's residents. These facilities were acquired using surplus maintenance and operating funds under the terms of a lease/purchase agreement in the amount of \$64,000. All of the District's facilities are being depreciated over their estimated useful life of 50 years. Depreciation in the amount of \$142,690 has been charged to system operations for the year and accumulated depreciation amounts to \$1,146,898 leaving a net book value of \$5,987,609.

#### 5. Bonds

At an election held within the District on November 3, 1998, voters authorized a total of \$6,670,000 combination unlimited tax and revenue bonds for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, acquiring, owning, improving, extending, maintaining, repairing, or operating a waterworks system, a sanitary sewer system, and a drainage and storm water system for the District.

On December 15, 2003, the District issued \$2,825,000 of these bonds dated January 1, 2004. The bonds mature serially on September 1, in each year 2005 through 2026, in principal amounts set forth on page 18. Bonds maturing on or after September 1, 2014, are subject to redemption, in whole or in part, on September 1, 2013, or on any date thereafter, at a price equal to the principal amount thereof plus accrued interest thereon to the date fixed for redemption. Bond maturing in the years 2019, 2024, and 2026 are also subject to mandatory redemption.

On February 23, 2005, the District issued another \$1,470,000 of these bonds dated March 1, 2005. The bonds mature serially on September 1, in each year 2006 through 2027, in principal amounts set forth on page 18. Bonds maturing on or after September 1, 2015, are subject to redemption, in whole or in part, on September 1, 2014, or on any date thereafter, at a price equal to the principal amount thereof plus accrued interest thereon to the date fixed for redemption. Bond maturing in the years 2017, 2020, 2024, and 2027 are also subject to mandatory redemption.


