Dear Administrative Law Judge Goodson:

On March 24, 2016 Public Utility Commission ("**PUC**") Staff filed its Response to Order No. 10 in this matter, finding the District's application administratively complete. On March 28, 2016, Order No. 11 was issued, affirming the PUC's Staff's findings and requiring the District to publish the approved notice for publication, to send notice to neighboring entities, customers, cities and landowners, and to submit verification of the same by April 25, 2016. With this filing, the District submits 10 copies of the Publisher's Affidavit, newspaper tear sheets for the two publications, and an Affidavit of mailed notice to Neighboring Entities, collectively attached hereto as **Attachment A**.
