Dear Mr. Collins:

On June 3, 2016, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your letter dated May 10, 2016 submitting an engineering report for the above public water system. On July 11, TCEQ received additional planning material via email.

The Lakeside WCID in the process of transferring a portion of the certificated service area from Manville Water Supply Corporation (WSC). According to the report, the Lakeside WCID 2-A currently has 98 single family lots with an additional 649 lots proposed. The submittal indicated that the water distribution system previously approved under the following water systems is owned by Lakeside WCID 2-A:

- Manville WSC- PWS ID No. 2270033 - Park at Blackhawk IV Phase 6 by TCEQ's letter May 14, 2008, Log No. 200804-116
- Lakeside WCID 2A - PWS ID No. 2270346 - The Park at Blackhawk IV; Phase 6B by TCEQ's letter dated October 6, 2014, Log No. P-0808214-046
- City of Pflugerville - PWS ID No. 2270014 - Park at Blackhawk IV Phase 7B by TCEQ's letter dated April 6, 2015, Log No. P - 02062015-050

Based on our review of the information submitted, **the engineering report generally addresses the minimum requirements of Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 290 - Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems.**

The interconnections between Lakeside WCID No. 2-A and Manville WSC are located at the intersection of Rowe Lane & Windham Drive, Rowe Lane & Carries Ranch Road and Speidel Drive & Hodde Lane. Since Lakeside WCID 2-A has become a public water system and is interconnected with Manville WSC, public water systems under separate administrative authority must have an interconnection agreement or contract and the contract/interconnection agreement must be made available to the TCEQ upon request.

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The submittal consisted of an engineering report, wholesale water supply contract between Tiemann Land and Cattle Development, Inc. and Manville Water Supply WSC and service contract between Lakeside WCID 2-A and Manville WSC. The project is to create a new public water system for Lakeside WCID No. 2-A and to provide retail water service within the proposed CCN boundary of Lakeside WCID No. 2-A.

Please refer to the Plan Review Team's Log No. P-06032016-014 in all correspondence for this project.

Please Note: In order to determine if a new source of water or a new treatment process results in corrosive or aggressive finished water that may endanger human health, we are requesting additional sampling and analysis of lead, alkalinity (as calcium carbonate), calcium (as calcium carbonate) and sodium in addition to the required chemical test results for public water system new sources. We are requiring these additional sampling results as listed in our currently revised checklists (Public Well Completion Data Checklist for Interim Use - Step 2 and Membrane Use Checklist - Step 2) which can be found on TCEQ's website at the following address:

Please include these additional sampling results in well completion submittals, membrane use submittals, and other treatment process submittals.

New surface water sources will need to also include lead, total dissolved solids, pH, alkalinity (as calcium carbonate), chloride, sulfate, calcium (as calcium carbonate) and sodium with the analysis required in 30 TAC Section 290.41(e)(1)(F).

Please complete a copy of the most current Public Water System Plan Review Submittal form for any future submittals to TCEQ. Every blank on the form must be completed to minimize any delays in the review of your project. The document is available on TCEQ's website at the address shown below. 

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
