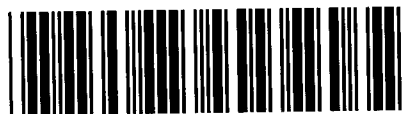

**ORDER NO. 6**  
**FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,**  
**ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

**I. Background**

On May 7, 2015, Order No. 5 was issued, requiring Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) and Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District 2C (Lakeside WCID 2C) (collectively the Applicants) to provide additional information regarding this application. On May 22, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2C filed an amended application to include a request for a new sewer CCN to Lakeside WCID 2C for the same service area to be included in its new water CCN, and draft notice in response to Order No. 5.

**II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application**

On June 30, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed comments on the amended application and draft notice. Commission Staff has determined that the application remains deficient and is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's June 30, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Mary Lupo and Tracy Harbour, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Applicants should not publish notice of the application until these discrepancies are corrected and approved by Staff.

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### III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until July 31, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

### IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Lakeside WCID 2C and Manville WSC's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **July 31, 2015**, Applicants shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **September 1, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
