In my opinion, the WCID 2-C has demonstrated adequate financial and managerial capability to provide service to the area contracted for release and transfer. These conclusions are based on information provided by the applicants prior to this date and may not reflect any changes in the applicants' status subsequent to this date.

Background

Tiemann Land & Cattle Development Inc. and Manville Water Supply Corporation entered an agreement as of October 07, 1996 to transfer a portion of CCN No. 11144 as a benefit of Lakeside WCID 2-C at a future date. After other assignments and agreements, a water utility service area agreement was entered into between the City of Pflugerville and Lakeside WCIDs # 1, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D to execute the initial transfer of the agreement cited above. This water utility service agreement was executed on August 16, 2013 and will transfer approximately 180.556 acres of overlapping boundary area and no `facilities from Manville WSC's CCN 11144 to the Lakeside WCID 2-C.

Lakeside WCID 2-C has provided water service to more than 399 connections as well as pumped 48,863,600 gallons and billed 48,863,600 gallons per their audited financial statements ending September 30, 2013. An unqualified opinion was issued for these statements indicating they represent fairly the financial position of Lakeside WCID 2-C in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles. Per the terms of the final agreement no compensation is required for the transfer of the CCN area. As of September 30, 2013 Lakeside WCID 2-C reported unassigned equity of \$406 thousand and a total cash amount of \$1.2 million. The change in total liabilities for Lakeside WCID 2-C decreased by \$27 thousand while the total fund balance increased by 437 thousand for FY2013. Lakeside WCID 2-C reported total revenues in excess of expenditures of \$437 thousand and the total assets of \$1.3 million before adjustments for FY2013 as well.

Independent Auditor's Report

Board of Directors

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the governmental activities and each major fund of Lakeside Water Control & Improvement District #2C (the District) as of and for the year ended September 30, 2013, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the District's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. As described in Note 11 to the financial statements, in 2013, the District adopted new accounting guidance, Government Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 65, *Items Previously Reported as Assets and Liabilities*. Our opinion is not modified with respect to this matter.

Other Matters

Required Supplementary Information

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that the management's discussion and analysis and the budgetary comparison information identified as Required Supplementary Information in the table of contents be presented to supplement the basic financial statements. Such information, although not a part of the basic financial statements, is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context. We have applied certain limited procedures to the required supplementary information in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, which consisted of inquiries of management about the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquiries, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge we obtained during our audit of the basic financial statements. We do not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the information because the limited procedures do not provide us with sufficient evidence to express an opinion or provide any assurance.

FINANCIAL ANALYSIS OF THE DISTRICT'S FUND LEVEL STATEMENTS

In comparison to the Government-wide statements, the Fund-level statements focus on the key funds of the District. The District uses fund accounting to ensure and demonstrate compliance with finance-related legal requirements.

The District reports the following types of Governmental funds: General Fund, Debt Service Fund and Capital Projects Fund. The focus of the District's Governmental funds is to provide information on near-term inflows, outflows, and available resources. Such information is useful in assessing the District's financing requirements. In particular, unassigned fund balance may serve as a useful measure of a government's net resources available at the end of the fiscal year.

The General Operating Fund, which pays for daily operating expenses, has a balance of \$406 thousand at the end of the current fiscal year. This is an increase of \$92 thousand over the prior fiscal year.

The Debt Service Fund increased by \$46 thousand during the current fiscal year. This fund remitted bond principal of \$140 thousand and bond interest of \$276 thousand during the year.

RE: Transfer of a Portion of Manville Water Supply Corporation's Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No. 11144 to Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District No. 2C

My client, Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District No. 2C ("District 2C"), files this application (the "Application") under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and 30 Texas Administrative Code § 291.117 to transfer a portion of Manville Water Supply Corporation's ("MWSC") water CCN No. 11144 to District 2C. This application does not contemplate the transfer of customers or water facilities. MWSC and District 2C are both "retail public utilities," as defined by Texas Water Code § 13.002(19) and Title 30 Texas Administrative Code § 291.3(39); and as retail public utilities, these entities have the authority to submit this CCN transfer request to the TCEQ.

The purpose of this Application is to transfer the portion of MWSC's water CCN No. 11144's boundaries that overlap with the boundaries of District 2C (the "Transfer Area"), to District 2C. Through a number of agreements and assignments, as detailed herein, District 2C and MWSC have agreed to this service area transfer.

Initially, on October 7, 1996, MWSC and Tiemann Land & Cattle Development, Inc. ("Tiemann") entered into a certain "Agreement for Providing Wholesale Water Service" (the "Agreement"), providing for the sale of a water supply and the transfer of a portion of water CCN No. 11144 for the benefit of District 2C. Specifically, under Section 2.8(b) of the Agreement, MWSC and Tiemann agreed that at some point in the future, at a time to be determined by Tiemann in his sole discretion, MWSC would transfer the portion of its water CCN No. 11144 that overlaps with District 2C to either Tiemann or the District. The relevant portion of Section 2.8(b) is as follows:

At any time after the creation of the District, Tiemann may file an application...with the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission seeking amendment of CCN No. 11144 to decertify the service area in which the Land is located and to transfer the authority to serve the Land to Tiemann or to the District proposed to be created. The Company [MWSC] agrees to consent to the decertification and transfer by signing a written consent in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "D".

To be clear, the term "Land," as used in Section 2.8, refers to the land that is now located within Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District ("LWCID") Nos. 1, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D, collectively, and the term "District" refers to these five Districts, which have all been created.

Then, on September 29, 2011, Tiemann and the City of Pflugerville entered into a certain Sixth Amendment to the Comprehensive Development Agreement, and in Section 7.1 of that Sixth Amendment, Tiemann agreed to transfer its right to obtain the water CCN service area that overlaps with LWCID Nos. 1, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D to the City.

Next, on September 11, 2013, LWCID Nos. 1, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D and the City of Pflugerville entered into a certain "Water Utility Service Area Agreement", where the City assigned its rights under Section 7.1 to LWCID Nos. 1, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D. Tiemann approved the form of this Water Utility Service Area Agreement.

Thus, District 2C now has the authority and right to request the transfer of the portion of MWSC's water CCN No. 11144 that is coterminous with the current boundaries of District 2C. MWSC has consented to this request. District 2C is already the retail water service provider to the residents within these boundaries, and, thus, the District clearly has the financial, managerial, and technical ability to serve this area. Again, there is no transfer of water infrastructure under this application because District 2C already owns and operates the infrastructure in place, and all of the customers receiving retail water service in this area are customers of District 2C.

CONSENT AND AGREEMENT OF MANYILLE WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION FOR WHOLESALE WATER SERVICE TO PROPERTY

Tiemann Land and Cattle Development, Inc. ("TLCD") and Manville Water Supply Corporation ("Manville") previously entered into that certain "Agreement for Providing Wholesale Water Service" dated October 7, 1996 (referred to herein as the "Wholesale Agreement"), concerning a certain 1113.57 acre tract of land (the "Land") located in Williamson and Travis Counties, Texas

The Wholesale Agreement defines the term "Service Area" to mean "all of the area within the boundaries of the Land, and also means and includes areas outside the boundaries of the Land that the parties hereto may mutually agree to provide Service to under this Agreement."

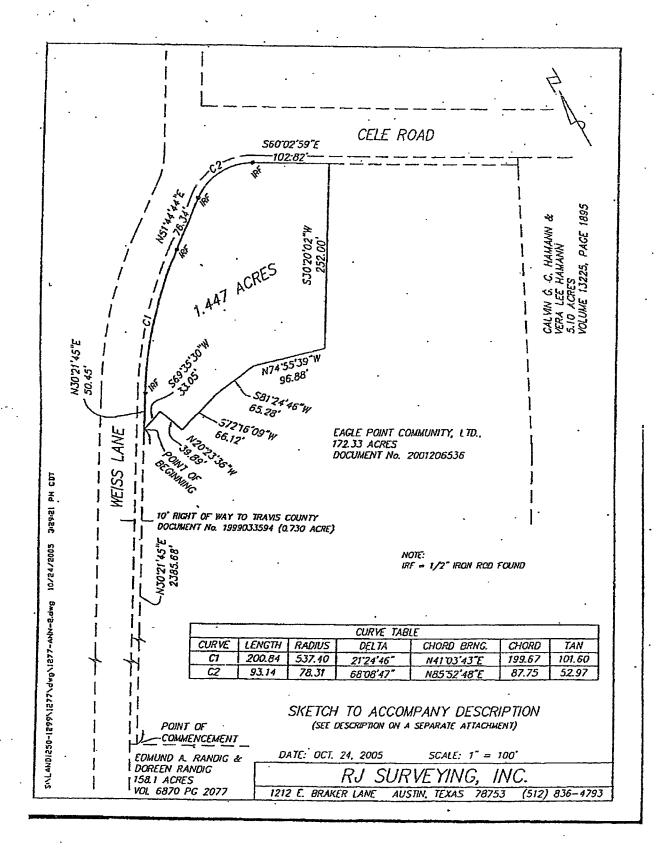

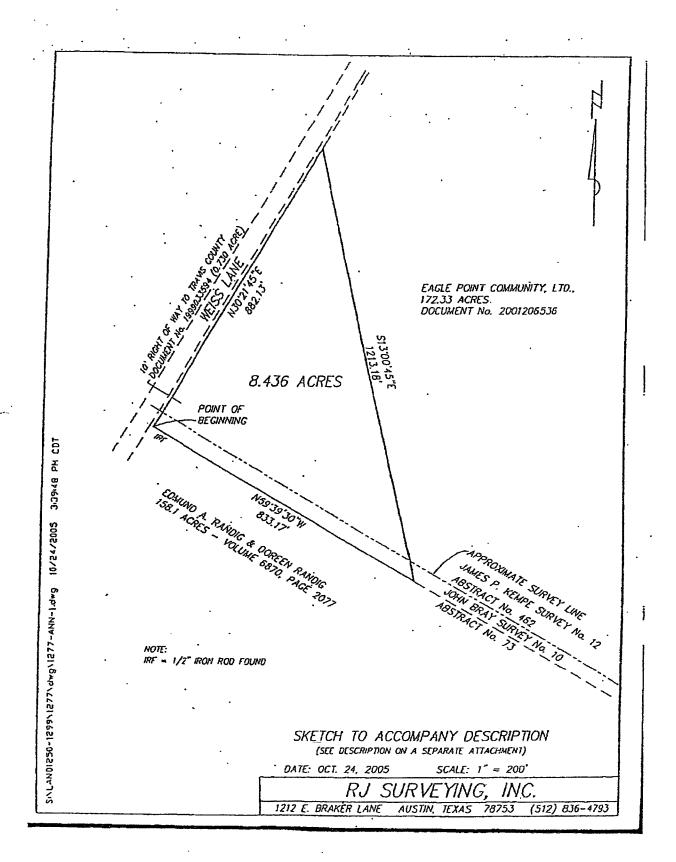
