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JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND JOINT PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, together with Lakeside Water Control Improvement District 2C (Lakeside WCID 2C or Applicant) (collectively, the Parties), and files this Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Joint Proposed Notice of Approval. In support thereof, the Parties show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 18, 2013, Lakeside WCID 2C and Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) filed a Contract Service Agreement with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) pursuant to Texas Water Code (TWC), Section § 13.248. On May 22, 2015, Lakeside filed an application to obtain water and sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Travis County. In addition, the application seeks to decertify a portion of Manville WSC's water CCN No. 11444. On October 14, 2016, Commission Staff filed a Final Recommendation in this docket, recommending that the application be approved.

II. JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE

(f) Lakeside WCID 2C's filing providing written consent from the City of Pflugerville (AIS Item No. 33, filed May 18, 2016);

(g) Affidavits of published and mailed notice (AIS Item No. 34, filed May 20, 2016);

(h) Lakeside WCID 2C's supplement to its application (AIS Item No. 35, filed May 25, 2016);

(i) Lakeside WCID 2C's Response to Staff's First RFI (AIS Item No. 40, filed June 21, 2016);

(j) Lakeside WCID 2C's Response to Staff's Second RFI (AIS Item No. 41, filed June 30, 2016);

(k) Lakeside WCID 2C's Response to Staff's Third RFI (AIS Item No. 43, filed July 6, 2016);

(1) Lakeside WCID 2C's supplements to its application (AIS Item No. 45, filed August 29, 2016);

(m) Lakeside WCID 2C's consent form (AIS Item No. 48, filed October 7, 2016);

(n) Manville Water Supply Corporation's consent form (AIS Item No. 49, filed October 10, 2016); and

(o) Commission Staff's recommendation that application be approved (AIS Item No. 50; filed October 14, 2016).

III. JOINT PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL

The attached Joint Proposed Notice of Approval would grant Lakeside WCID 2C's application to obtain CCN No. 13245 for the water service area and CCN No. 21094 for the

sewer service area, both in Travis County, Texas. Also attached are the final maps, certificates, and consent forms that were included in Staff's recommendation on final disposition filed October 14, 2016.

IV. CONCLUSION

The Parties respectfully request that the Commission grant the motion to admit the evidence specified above, and adopt the attached Joint Proposed Notice of Approval.

JOINT PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Joint Notice of Approval addresses the application (Application) of Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District 1 (Lakeside WCID 2C or Applicant) to obtain CCN No. 13244 for the water service area and CCN No. 21093 for the sewer service area, both in Travis County, Texas. In addition, the Application seeks to decertify a portion of Manville Water Supply Corporation's (Manville WSC's) water CCN No. 11444. The Public Utility Commission Staff recommended approval of this Application. The Application is approved.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

Procedural History and Background

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- 1. On November 18, 2013, Lakeside WCID 2C and Manville WSC filed a Contract Service Agreement with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) pursuant to Texas Water Code (TWC), Section § 13.248.
- 2. On September 1, 2014, the economic regulation of water and wastewater utilities was transferred to the Commission by the act of the Legislature.
- 3. On November 5, 2014, Order No. 1 was issued addressing water program transfer and procedural matters.
- 4. On November 5, 2014, Order No. 2 was issued requiring Staff to file comments on the status of this proceeding, a recommendation on the need for a hearing or on final

disposition of the Application, if appropriate, or propose a procedural schedule, if necessary.

5. On December 15, 2014, Staff filed comments on the status of this proceeding and requested an extension of time to file a recommendation on final disposition, request for a hearing on the merits, or propose a procedural schedule.

6. On December 18, 2014, Order No. 3 was issued extending deadlines.

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7. On January 23, 2015, Staff filed a response to Order No. 3, recommending that Lakeside WCID 2C supplement and clarify the Application.

- 8. On January 29, 2015, Order No. 4 was issued establishing revised deadlines and providing Lakeside WCID 2C an opportunity to supplement and clarify the Application.
- 9. On February 19, 2015, Manville WSC filed a response to Order No. 4, clarifying the
 ⁴¹ Application.
- 10. On February 23, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2C filed a response to Order No. 4, clarifying theApplication.
- 11. On March 20 and 23, 2015, Staff filed a response to Order No. 4, requesting additional information from Lakeside WCID 2C and proposing a procedural schedule.+
- 12. On May 7, 2015, Order No. 5 was issued requiring Lakeside WCID 2C and Manville WSC to provide additional information regarding the Application.
- 13. On May 22, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2C filed a response to Order No. 5, amending the Application and providing draft notice.
- 14. On June 30, 2015, Staff filed a response to Order No. 5, recommending that the Application be found administratively incomplete.
- 15. On July 10, 2015, Order No. 6 was issued finding the Application to be deficient,
 establishing revised deadlines, and providing Lakeside WCID 2C an opportunity to cure the deficiencies.

- 16. On July 31, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2C amended its Application with supplemental materials.
- 17. On September 1, 2015, Staff filed a response to Order No. 6, recommending that the Application be found administratively incomplete.
- 18. On September 4, 2015, Order No. 7 was issued finding the Application to be deficient, establishing revised deadlines, and providing Lakeside WCID 2C an opportunity to cure
- ^t the deficiencies.

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- ¹ 19. On October 1, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2C amended its Application with supplemental ¹ materials.
- 20. On November 2, 2015, Staff filed a response to Order No. 7, recommending that the Application be found administratively incomplete.
- 21. On November 4, 2015, Order No. 8 was issued finding the Application to be deficient, establishing revised deadlines, and providing Lakeside WCID 2C an opportunity to cure the deficiencies.
- 22. On December 4, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2C amended its Application with supplemental materials.
- 23. On January 7, 2016, Staff filed a response to Order No. 8, recommending that the Application be found administratively incomplete.
- 24. On January 13, 2016, Order No. 9 was issued finding the Application to be deficient,
 establishing revised deadlines, and providing Lakeside WCID 2C an opportunity to cure
 the deficiencies.
- 25. On February 9, 2016, Lakeside WCID 2C amended its Application with supplemental materials.
- 26. On March 9, 2016, Staff filed a request for an extension of time to file its response to Order No. 9.

27. On March 10, 2016, Order No. 10 was issued revising the procedural schedule.

- 28. On March 16, 2016, Lakeside WCID 2C amended its Application with supplemental materials.
- 29. On March 30, 2016, Staff filed a request for an extension of time to file its response to Order No. 10.
- 30. On April 1, 2016, Order No. 11 was issued revising the procedural schedule.
- 31. On April 19, 2016, Staff filed a response to Order No. 11, recommending that the Application be found administratively complete.
- 32. On April 20, 2016, Order No. 12 was issued, finding the Application sufficient for filing.
- 33. On June 10, 2016, Staff filed a response to Order No. 12 proposing an additional procedural schedule.
- 34. On June 13, 2016, Order No. 13 was issues, adopting an additional procedural schedule.
- 35. Notice was provided by publication in *The Pflugerville Pflag* on April 27 and May 4, 2016, and in the *Round Rock Leader* on April 28 and May 5, 2016. The Publisher's affidavit dated May 5, 2016, and signed by Alejandro Cado, the legal advertising representative of *The Pflugerville Pflag* and the *Round Rock Leader*, attests to this notice.
- 36. Lakeside WCID 2C mailed notice of the Application to neighboring systems, landowners, and cities and to neighboring utilities and affected parties on April 25, 2016. An Affidavit that these entities received notice was dated May 16, 2016.
- 37. Order Nos. 14 and 15, issued August 26 and September 27, 2016, respectively, revised the procedural schedule.
- 38. On October 14, 2016, Staff filed its Final Recommendation in response to Order No. 15, recommending that the Application be approved.

- 39. On October 18, 2016, Staff and Lakeside WCID 2C filed a joint proposed motion to admit evidence and joint proposed notice of approval.
- 40. Informal Disposition

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41. More than 15 days has passed since completion of the notice provided in this docket effective May 5, 2016.

42. No issues of fact or law remain disputed by any party; therefore no hearing is necessary.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Commission has jurisdiction and authority over this docket pursuant to TWC §§ 13.041 and 13.241, and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.102 (TAC).

Lakeside WCID 2C is a retail public utility as defined in TWC § 13.002(19) and 16 TAC § 24.3(58).

 Public notice of the Application was provided in compliance with TWC §13.246 and 16 TAC § 24.106.

4. Lakeside WCID 2C has provided evidence that it has adequate financial, managerial and technical capability to provide service to the area subject to the amendment in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.102.

5. Lakeside WCID 2C possess the technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.102.

6. Lakeside WCID 2C has demonstrated that obtaining CCN Nos. 13245 and 21094 is necessary for the service, accommodation, convenience, and safety of the public.

7. The requirements for informal disposition pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met inthis proceeding.

III. ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following Order:

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1. Lakeside WCID 2C's Application is approved.

2. Lakeside WCID 2C is hereby granted CCN Nos. 13245 and 21094.

3. Manville WSC's CCN No. 11444 is hereby amended.

4. All other motions, requests for entry of specific findings of fact and conclusions of law, and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted herein, are denied.

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
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
