**ORDER NO. 4
REQUIRING SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION**

I. Background

On January 23, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a response to Order No. 3, regarding the status of Manville Water Supply Corporation's (Manville WSC) and Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District 2C's (Lakeside WCID 2C) application to approve a contract service agreement pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 13.248, in Travis County.

**II. Staff Recommendation/Comments on Status of the Application and
Request for Supplemental Information**

Commission Staff stated that the application is not entirely clear as to what relief is requested. Commission Staff also stated that the applicants did not fully cite specific statutory authority or Commission rules in support thereof.

As Staff understands, Manville WSC is singly certificated to serve a parcel of land consisting of approximately 408.148 acres that is located within Lakeside WCID 2C. Manville WSC will transfer this portion of its certificated area to Lakeside WCID 2C, making this 408.148 acre parcel of land singly certified to Lakeside WCID 2C. Thus, Commission Staff interprets the application as a request for three types of relief:

1. Transfer of a portion of Manville WSC's service area to Lakeside WCID 2C;
2. Amendment of Manville WSC's certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to reflect this transfer; and
3. Grant of a new CCN to Lakeside WCID 2C for the transferred service area.

Commission Staff requested that applicants be ordered to file a response clarifying the full extent of the relief sought in this proceeding. Specifically, Commission Staff requested that applicants be ordered to file a response affirming or denying Staff's interpretation of the application. Further, in the event applicants disagree with Commission Staff's interpretation of the application, order applicants to provide a detailed explanation of the relief sought.

III. Providing Opportunity to Supplement and Clarify Application

Commission Staff's request is granted. As specifically described in Commission Staff's January 23, 2015 filing, applicants shall file supplemental information clarifying the full extent of the relief sought in this proceeding, fully cite specific statutory authority or Commission rules in support thereof, and affirm or deny Commission Staff's interpretation of the application. Additionally, if applicants disagree with Commission Staff's interpretation of the application, applicants shall provide a detailed statement explaining the relief requested and specifying under which rules and statutes the relief is being requested.

In addition to the clarifying information required above, applicants shall provide supplemental information to address the following issues:

1. If the applications in Dockets 42931, 42932, 42933, 42934 and 42935 are ultimately approved, would Manville WSC still retain a service area and it's CCN?
2. Is any part of Manville WSC's public water system (PWS) affected by this application? Does any portion of the service area that the applicants seek to transfer in this application contain facilities that are part of Manville WSC's PWS?
3. Is consolidation of Docket Nos. 42931, 42932, 42933, 42934, and 42935 appropriate?


IV. Proposed Procedural Schedule
