ORDER NO. 8 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Background

On September 4, 2015, Order No. 7 was issued in this proceeding, requiring Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) and Lakeside Water Control and Improvement District 2D (Lakeside WCID 2D) (collectively the Applicants) to provide additional information to cure deficiencies in the application that have previously been identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff. On October 1, 2015, Lakeside WCID 2D filed supplemental documents.

II. Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On November 2, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) recommended that the application remains deficient and is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's November 2, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Mary Lupo and Tracy Montes, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicants be given until December 10, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file by January 8,

2016, additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

IV. Technical Review

Additionally, Commission Staff identified certain information necessary in order for Staff to complete its technical review of the application. Specially, Applicants shall submit the following: (1) a signed agreement to decertify a portion of the City of Pflugerville's sewer CCN No. 20678; and (2) documentation showing consent from LCRA to allow Lakeside WCID 2D to provide retail water and sewer service within LCRA's district boundary.

V. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Lakeside WCID 2D and Manville WSC's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Applicants should not publish notice of the application until these discrepancies are corrected and approved by Staff. On or before **December 10, 2015**, Applicants shall amend this application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **January 8, 2016,** Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
