The water system was granted an exception on May 29, 2003, to the sanitary control easement rule, contingent upon collection of one raw bacteriological sample required monthly from the well. GENERAL FACILITY

North Orange Water & Sewer Service LLC, (NOWS) maintains a sewage treatment plant and collections system that serves the Country Squire Subdivision located north of Orange, Texas, off Highway 87. The wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) is a modified activated sludge plant operated in the extended aeration mode, with the following units: an influent lift station, a bar screen, three aeration basins in series, one clarifier, gas chlorination, two aerated chlorine contact chambers (CCCs) in series, a 90-degree V-notch weir, and an aerobic sludge digester. The domestic wastewater collection system has one offsite lift station. The alleged unauthorized discharge is located at 8505 Shakespear Drive.

BACKGROUND:

There has been one previous complaint against this facility. On July 18, 2011, a complaint was received regarding sewage backing up during heavy rainfall events and overflowing a clean out. A site investigation was conducted and no evidence of an overflow from the clean out was noted. No violations were noted during the investigation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The initial attempt to contact the requestor on March 5, 2012, was unsuccessful and the investigator left a voice message. Mr. Buford Mooney, the operator of the wastewater treatment system was contacted on March 5, 2012, and was informed of the complaint. Mr. Mooney, stated he was aware of the complaint. He stated that the lift station serving the collection system had a pump failure during the most recent rain event causing the sewer to back up. He stated that he had received a report about difficulty flushing. He stated the they televised the main line and that they did not detect any issues. He also stated that they would be installing an additional clean out at the requestor's service tap. Mr. Mooney stated a new pump was on order and that he would provide documentation of its installation. The requestor was subsequently contacted on March 5, 2012, and indicated they were located within 100 feet of the main line and have difficulty flushing every time there is heavy rain. The requestor stated during the last rain event that the commode did not overflow, but in past years that it has. The requestor stated plumbers televised their service line and indicated there were no issues with the line.

Mr. Mooney was contacted on March 21, 2012, and was requested to provide a status update on the installation of the new lift station pump. He stated the installation was complete and that the documentation had already been mailed. On March 22, 2012, NOWS provided documentation and photographs showing the installation of a new pump in the lift station serving the collection system. The correspondence also indicated they have had severe rain since the installation of the new pump and have not had any additional complaints from the requestor.

On March 21, 2012, Mr. Mooney contacted this office and left a message stating the requestor had pulled off the spring loaded cleanout cover and that rising water had gotten in the requestor's house. Mr. Mooney's call was returned, and he stated the requestor pulled the cap off the clean out and does not know how water got into the house. Mr. Mooney stated the whole neighborhood was flooded. He stated the requestor indicated it came from the sewer.

On March 21, 2012, the requestor was contacted and they indicated they removed the clean out cover in anticipation of the coming storm to increase flow out of the clean out. The requestor reported that their spouse observed sewer overflowing from the commode in their bathroom. The requestor stated their yard was dry, but, their neighbors were flooded.

Mr Mooney was contacted on March 21, 2012, and was requested to provide an unauthorized discharge report for sanitary sewer system overflow at the requestor's residence. Mr. Mooney suggested that that the installation of a grinder station at the residence may provide relief if sewer service at this residence continues to be an issue. On March 23, 2012, an unauthorized discharge report was received from Mr Mooney The report indicates the discharge was the result of a 10 inch rainfall event.

On April 19, 2012, the requestor contacted this office and left a message regarding their sewer service. They indicated during the last rain event they had trouble flushing their commode. Attempts to contact the requestor the same day were unsuccessful. Mr. Mooney was contacted

on April 19, 2012, and was informed of the message. Mr Mooney stated they did not receive any reports of sewer service issues with the recent rains. However, he did state that the WWTP and lift station controls had been damage by lighting during the rainfall event and subsequently repaired. He stated the lift station did not overflow and that the sewer backed up into the collection system. He did not report any discharges from the collection system associated with the rainfall event.

On April 26, 2012, Mr. Bobby Manshack, NOWS President, was contacted and informed of the results of the investigation. He indicated he was aware of the complaint and they would continue to be receptive to the requestor should additional issues arise.

One alleged and resolved violation for the unauthorized discharge of wastewater was addressed during this investigation. NOWS addressed the sewage backup by installing a new lift station pump and by subsequently repairing the damaged controls from a lighting strike. Attempts to contact, discuss, and inform the requestor of the results of this complaint on April 19, 23, & 26, 2012, were unsuccessful. The requestor was notified of the results of this investigation by letter No further action necessary.
