Your application for the City of Thrall, to amend the CCN was received on January 28, 2010, and has been accepted for filing. Thank you for providing the items we requested with your February 26, 2010, letter. Ms. Sheresia Perryman has been assigned to perform the technical review.

Your next step is to provide the revised public notices without delay. The notice to the public must be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Williamson County. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide correct notice of the application to any utilities and cities within two (2) miles of your proposed service area, any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area or other affected parties in your requested area. You will also be required to provide mailed notice to all landowners with more than 25 acres in your proposed CCN area pursuant to TCEQ 30 TAC Chapter 291 Rules adopted on January 5, 2006. The landowner information may be obtained from the county appraisal district tax rolls for the county or counties in which the proposed CCN lies. Check the notices carefully before mailing or publishing.

A review of our files and maps indicates that, in addition to the neighboring utilities noted on your application, you must provide notice to the following entity:

- b) four copies of each individual notice and map sent to neighboring utilities and affected parties;.
- c) four copies of notice and map sent to each landowner; and
- d) an original and three copies of the signed affidavits that individual notice to neighboring utilities, affected individuals <u>and each landowner</u> has been given. (Copies of the Affidavit forms are enclosed with this letter.)

Please be sure to include a map showing the proposed service area with your individual notices to neighboring utilities, other affected parties and each landowner. It is the applicant's burden to provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each individual notice.

After further technical review additional financial, technical or other information may also be requested through future correspondence.

These items must be completed and returned to our office by <u>April 9, 2010</u>. Processing of this application cannot proceed until the close of the 30 day public comment period which begins after all the required notices have been given. If we do not receive the requested information by this date, your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.

City of Thrall has filed an application to amend CCN No. 13063 with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide water utility service in Williamson County.

The proposed utility service area is located adjacent to the city limits of Thrall, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by approximately 1,000 feet north of US 79; on the east by approximately 1,800 feet east of CR 424; on the south by approximately 2, 500 feet south of US 79; and on the west by approximately 1, 500 feet west of Neil St. The total area being requested includes approximately 47.6 acres and 0 current customers. The proposed amendment affects customers and/or areas located in the following zip code: 76578.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to exclude the tract from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All request to opt out of the requested service area must

include a scaled, general location map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land.

Persons who meet the requirements to opt out, and wish to request this option should file the required documents with the:
