ADOPTING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 15, 2012, the Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) filed a proposed procedural schedule. No party has opposed the proposed schedule, which is adopted with modifications, as follows:

Date	Deadline
September 14, 2012	Last day to server written discovery.
October 16, 2012	Discovery ends including depositions.
October 30, 2012	Mediation.
November 6, 2012	Applicant's prefiled direct and exhibits (includes exhibit index and list of witnesses in order of presentation and summary of testimony).
November 27, 2012	Protestant's prefiled direct and exhibits (includes exhibit index and list of witnesses in order of presentation and summary of testimony).
December 18, 2012	ED's prefiled direct and exhibits (includes exhibit index and list of witnesses in order of presentation and summary of testimony). Dispositive motions are due.
January 18, 2013	Objections to prefiled testimony and exhibits. Applicant provides list of rebuttal witnesses and summary of testimony.
January 25, 2013	Replies to objections to prefiled testimony and exhibits. Responses to dispositive motions
February 27-28, 2012	Hearing on the merits set to begin at 9:00 a.m.

The hearing on the merits in this docket to begin at 9:00 a.m., on February 27, 2013, at the State Office of Administrative Hearings, 300 West 15th Street, 4th Floor, Austin, Texas. The hearing is expected to last two days, but shall continue until completed.
