**ORDER NO. 25  
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION**

This Order requires Commission Staff to clarify whether and to what extent the consent of Noack Water Supply Corporation is necessary before this application can be approved. On April 20, 2017, Commission Staff filed a unanimous stipulation and settlement agreement, motion to admit evidence, and proposed notice of approval in this proceeding. Commission Staff provided an amended water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) and service area map for the City of Thrall. However, Commission Staff did not provide a consent or an amended certificate for Noack WSC.

Therefore, before a notice is issued in this application, Commission Staff shall clarify whether the water service area requested by the City in this application is currently uncertificated or whether this application would remove the requested service area from an existing CCN. Further, if the water service area requested by the City will be removed from a current water CCN, Commission Staff shall provide all necessary documentation for that decertification, including an amended certificate for the current CCN holder and proof that the current CCN holder consented to the decertification and consented to the proposed maps and certificates as prepared by Commission Staff.

On or before May 19, 2017, Commission Staff shall provide the requested clarification and may propose additional deadlines, if necessary.
